

Attached are plans and petition for a reconstruction of the Oliver Armstrong Drain in the Wellington Northeast Subdivision. The petition was filed by William L. Taylor. Cost of Profeser Reconstruction is to be Paip By Petitions.

The reconstruction consists of straightening approximately forty (40') feet of the open ditch on Lot 134, which is owned by William Taylor. Also affected by the work is a small portion of Lot 135, owned by Marc F. and Lisa A. Farris, Tract 11-07-03-16-007.000. The proposal will not affect the length of the drain.

The petition will move the drain easement onto Lot 124, which is owned by Joseph B. Weems, IV and Linda C., Tract 11-07-03-09-05505580 ->002.000. The easement will move approximately twenty (20') feet West at the greatest point.
