It is my opinion as County Surveyor of Hamilton County that the improvement of each drain will:

- 1. Improve public health
- 2. Benefit the public highways of Hamilton County and the public streets in Carmel and Noblesville
- 3. Drain the grounds of a public school

AND

4. Be of public utility

On behalf of the people affected by the areas I present with this request the petition that some action be taken to correct the inhabital conditions that are present due to the lack of maintenance and the drain being inadequate to handle an urban area.


