Re: Jonas Rogers Drain – J.M. Gustin Arm

Attached is a petition filed by Patricia Smothers, Patrick M & Deborah Riley and Ronald G. Miller for an Arm to the Jonas Rogers regulated drain to be located in White River Township. I have reviewed the petition and have found it to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway, and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by regulating this arm to this drain. The drain will consist of the following:

Existing 12" Clay - 404 ft.

The total length of the drain will be 404 feet.

The arm will connect to the Tipton County J.M. Gustin Regulated Drain at the Hamilton County/Tipton County line, as described in Tipton County Drainage Book 11, page 505. The starting point for the arm is at the terminus on the south line of the S.E. ¼ of Section 35, Township 21 North, Range 5 East and thence run south to its outlet into the Jonas Roger Regulated Drain at a point approximately 400 feet south and 148 feet west of the Northeast corner of Section 2, Township 20 North, Range 5 East. The drain is to be accepted in place without reconstruction costs or assessments.

Parcels benefitted by this drain are currently assessed for the Jonas Rogers Drain. Therefore no changes in the current assessment shall be required.

The easement for the proposed arm across tracts 07-03-02-00-007.000 and 07-03-02-00-00-004.001 shall be 75 feet from the centerline on both sides of the tile as set out in IC 36-9-27-33. The easement for the proposed arm across tract 07-03-02-00-006.000 owned by Patricia D. Smothers, shall be 25 feet from the centerline on the west side of the tile and 75 feet from the centerline on the east side of the tile.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **Jonas Rogers Drain, J. M. Gustin Arm** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing **on April 22, 2013**, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the *Jonas Rogers Drain*, *J. M. Gustin Arm* be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:


The Board issued an order declaring the proposed improvement established. Such findings and order were marked filed and are available for inspection in the Office of the Hamilton County Surveyor.
