

Re: George Booth Drain

Upon review of the maintenance fund for the <u>George Booth</u> Drain, I found that the drain is currently in the red by \$2,122.99. Therefore, the Board should consider increasing the assessment rate for this drain.

This drain was certified for assessment on <u>July 12, 1979</u> at a rate of \$2.00 per acre, \$3.00 minimum. This assessment has remained at this rate since that time. With <u>179.54</u> acres and <u>1</u> lot in the drainage shed the current annual assessment is \$381.76.

Over the last <u>10</u> years the drain has had the following work orders:

Along with these work orders the drain has been sprayed in the following years at the following cost:

1996 TOTAL	\$200.00 \$350.00
1996	\$200.00
1992	\$150.00

Based on the above the present average annual cost for maintenance is only \$283.90. However, due to the rapidly approaching development in the area I recommend the Board consider increasing the assessment rate for this drain to the following:

- 1. Maintenance assessment for roads and streets be set at $\frac{10.00}{100}$ per acre.
- 2. Maintenance assessment for agricultural tracts increase to \$5.00 per acre-the minimum should increase from \$3.00 to \$20.00 minimum.

- 3. Maintenance assessment for nonplatted residential tracts be set at \$5.00 per acre with an increase to a \$20.00 minimum.
- 4. Maintenance assessment for future commercial, multifamily residential, and institutional tracts be set at \$10.00 per acre with a \$50.00 minimum.
- 5. Maintenance assessment for future platted lots in subdivisions whose drainage systems will not be part of the regulated drain (those systems maintained by the <u>City of Noblesville/Town of</u> <u>Westfield</u>) shall be set at \$35.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within non-regulated drain subdivisions shall be assessed at \$5.00 per acre with a \$35.00 minimum.
- 6. Maintenance assessment for platted lots within a subdivision whose drainage system will be part of the regulated drain shall be set at \$65.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within regulated drain subdivisions shall be set at \$10.00 per acre with a \$65.00 minimum.

This will create an annual maintenance assessment of \$1,308.68.

Upon review of the drainage shed for the George Booth Drain, I believe that the drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, the George Booth Drain should be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this item for <u>May 29</u>, 2001.
