Attached is a petition, plans, non-enforcement request, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Section 4 Arm Bridgewater Drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

12" RCP 149 feet 18" RCP 158 feet

The total length of the drain will be 307 feet.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$30.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$30.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this section will be \$450%

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain the Board also approved the non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the secondary plat for Bridgewater Section 4 as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for September 1996.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Petetioner believes the proposed improvements will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the drainage system and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter.

- 3. The Petitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain File.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The County Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures at Petitioners cost as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain.

During construction, changes were made to the drain which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain dated August 19, 1997. The changes are as follows:

Str. 701-702 12"RCP shortened from 100'feet to 97' feet.

Str. 702-703 18"RCP shortened from 158' feet to 155' feet.

6"SSD was placed under the curb for a total of 2,206' feet.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 2,458 feet.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on September 23, 1996 and recorded under instrument #9609654243.

The bond or letter of credit from Frontier Insurance Co., number 77784 for erosion control, 77785 for storm sewers, 77786 for subsurface drainage, and 77787 for monumentation; dated June 20, 1996, in the amount of \$8,000.00, \$9,200.00, \$12,773.00 and \$750.00; has been recommended for release in a letter to the Commissioners dated August 25, 1997.






