Court met at 8 1/2 o'clock a.m. pursuant to adjournment.

Present the Hon. R. R. Stephenson Judge and all Court officers.

Whereupon the sheriff proclaimed said Court open and the following proceedings were had therein:

Drainage, No. 951.

Come now the commissioners heretofore appointed herein and file herein their report as follows:

Report of Commissioners.

To the honorable judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage, to whom was referred the petition of Thomas N. Butler for the drainage of the West half of the North West quarter of the South East quarter also North East quarter of South West quarter South East quarter of South West quarter Sec 17, T. 20, R. 4 East.

Also South East quarter of the North West quarter South West quarter of the North West quarter North West quarter of the North West quarter North East quarter of the North West quarter. All in Sec 7, T. 20, R. 4 East in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work, and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will be of public utility, a benefit to the tract & the neighborhood and will benefit public highways and that the same can be accomplished at an expense less than the aggregate benefits to the lands to be affected thereby and after making the necessary surveys and examinations they are of the opinion that the method of drainage should be as follows to wit:

Beginning at or near the south West corner of the North East quarter of the South East quarter of sec 17, T. 20, R. 4 East on the land heretofore described belonging to Thomas N. Butler and running thence North 4° 30' East 350 ft. Thence North 57° East 150 ft. Thence North 43° East 220 ft. Thence

The report of the viewers was favorable and was filed.

Report of R. D. Horney, County Surveyor, who was appointed to supervise the construction of above drain, would respectfully report that he has made a survey of the above drain and did proceed and definitely determine the best and cheapest method of drainage, the terminal and route, location, character of the proposed work, and fix the same by metes and bounds, courses and distances and descriptions, including grades and bench marks including all necessary areas, estimated the cost thereof, divided the drain or ditch into sections of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section, assessed the benefits of damages as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the water shed to be affected thereby and to easements held by railways or other public or private corporations, or towns, including

any land rights, easements, or water power, injuriously or beneficially affected, and do make report to the court under oath.

LOCATION Begin near the center of Section 17, Township 20 North, Range 4 East, thence in a northerly direction terminating in Cicero Creek. Approximately 80 rods East and 60 rods North of the center of Section 8, Township 20 North, Range 4 East, in Jackson Township, Hamilton County. Approximately 4 miles West and $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles North of Arcadia; or 2 miles East of State Road #31, and $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles South of County line between Hamilton and Tipton County.

REQUIREMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The old tile ditch is under the fence and several fence posts have been driven through the tile and damaging the ditch so it will not work.

At Terminus - Construct open ditch from Cicero Creek South approximately 250 Lin. ft. 3 ft. wide tile in slope $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 at end of tile. 1 piece of ~~16"~~^{16"} / 5" corrugated pipe 16.0 feet long with corrugated end section, at road between Sections 17 - Sec. 8 construct 12" open inlet. Thence South approximately 10 ft. West of fence line 1 row 12" tile, approximately 1320 lin. feet † or -. And connect to old ditch. Also 15" open inlet near the deep cut. Also grub and clear old cut at least 25 ft. on each side of tile. Inspect and repair. Inspect any other places as Engineer or authorized representative requires. Make 2 connections from old ditch to new - as indicated by Engineer.
