Re: Thomas Butler Drain

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Thomas Butler Drain. The relocation is being proposed by Beck's Hybrids. The proposal is to enclose 400 feet of open ditch using 15" concrete tile. The new tile will lie East of the existing drain approximately 15 feet. The existing open ditch will be filled. The plan prepared by the Hamilton County SWCD calls for the tile to intercept the existing tile approximately 30 feet North of 281st St. and run North along the East side of the drain and outlet back into the open ditch.

This line will consist of the following:

400' of 15" tile

20' of 18" CMP

The total length of new tile shall be 400 feet. The 400 feet of original drain between STA 77+20 and STA 81+20 shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 0 feet to the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Beck's Hybrids. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioner's property, the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition.



Therefore, the net additional length of the drain due to this project remains at **0 feet**.


The bond or letter of credit from Community Bank, number 235; dated August 25, 2000; in the amount of \$6,130.00; was released June 26, 2000.
