To the Honorable Board of Commssioners of Hamilton County, Indiana:--

The undersigned, Surveyor of Hamilton County, to whom was referred the above entitled petition for drainage on the 12th day of December, 1907, would respectfully report, that on the 31st day of Becember, 1907, and on the 7th day of January, 1908, I made all the necessary surveys and personal inspection of the real estate described in the petition and all lands likely to be effected by the proposed work and that I would respectfully report as follows:- That the drainage as proposed in said petition is practicable; that the same when constructed will improve thepublic health and will be ofpublic utility. That there will be one public highway benefited by drain.

I would further report that the cost of construction, **HANN** damages and expenses of effecting said proposed drainage will be less than the benefits to the owners of land likely to be effected by said proposed drainage.

STONE WALL.

At Sation 41 + 75 to be constructed a stone retaining wall wall 16' X 5' X 2' as shown on attached drawing. Said **wark** to be built of field rock laid up in mortar made from one part Portland Cement and three parts clean, sharp sand and so constructed to receive the tile at proper grade 2' above the base of the wall.

LAYING TILE, FILLING DTICH, DEADENING, ETC.
