Attached is the petition from the Town of Fishers for the Castetter - Randall Drain Reconstruction. The Arm of the Castetter - Randall is being reconstructed to allow for the reconstruction of the 116th Street - Phase 2 project.

The proposed reconstruction of the existing drain will realign the curb inlet and side swale inlets for the 116^{th} Street - Phase 2 extension. The Drain to be reconstructed will be increased in size from 12 inch RCP to a 15 inch RCP and structures set to replace the existing structures. No additional capacity will be added to the Castetter- Randall Drain to be replaced. The design changes for this Drain were done by Butler, Fairman and Seifert, INC.

The proposed Castetter - Randall Drain to be replaced will cross 116th Street approximately 100 feet west of the Regency Drive/Fishers Point Boulevard from STA 0+00 in south R/W to STA 1+20 in the north R/W.
