Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Bower Farms Arm, Silas Davis Drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD - 570 feet

The total length of the drain will be 570 feet.

The SSD, which will be regulated, is as follows: Rear of tract 1 and run of SSD to tract 10 from structure on Silas Davis Drain at station 5+10. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain.

There will be no change in the current assessment for the Davis Drain with the construction of this arm.

Parcels assessed for this drain may be assessed for the Emery Clark/Findley Creek Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for August 27, 2001.


The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on August 27, 2001 and recorded under instrument #200300025815. A bond or letter of credit was not obtained.


I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
