Re: Harmon Clark Drain, West Oak Industrial Park Arm

Attached is a petition filed by L. Dale Hinshaw, Hinshaw Services along with a non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the West Oak Industrial Park Arm, Harmon Clark Drain to be located in Washington Township. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD	3,023 ft	15" RCP	173 ft	27" RCP	399 ft
12" RCP	118 ft	24" RCP	81 ft	30" RCP	380 ft

The pipe lengths listed above are as shown on the plans for West Oak Industrial Park by Weihe Engineers, Inc. dated April 14, 2004 with last revision date June 4, 2004.

The total length of new tile shall be 4,174 feet. The 635 feet of original drain between Sta. 6+50 and 0+15 shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 3,539 feet to the drains total length.

The temporary swale from Structures 212, 211 and 210 will not become part of the regulated drain. The drainage from these structures will be taken into the lake proposed with Kensington Carriage Homes at Oak Trace. Any additional pipe installed will be picked up as regulated drain when the plans are finalized for Kensington Carriage Homes.

The retention pond (lake) located in Common Area "A" is to be considered part of the regulated drain. The inlet, outlet and banks will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the pond (lake), such as mowing and aquatic vegetation, will be the responsibility of the property owner. The Board will also retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the lake was designed will be retained. Thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated drain are those located under the curbs. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the easement (right of way) are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain.

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I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$35.00 per acre for common areas and commercial lots with a \$75.00 minimum and \$10.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$25.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$1,176.88.

The petitioner has submitted surety for the proposed drain at this time. Surety shall be submitted prior to the approval of the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners/commencement of construction. The sureties, which are in the form of a Performance Bond, are as follows:

Parcels assess for this drain may be assessed for the Wheeler & Beals or Cool Creek Drains at sometime in the future.

I believe that this drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. The request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the survey for West Oak Industrial Park as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder as instrument number 200400044585. The easement widths are shown on Exhibit A of the drainage easement agreement to be recorded along with the non-enforcement request.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for March 28, 2005.

In the matter of Westoak Industrial Park Subdivision, Section Harmon Clark Legal Drain Petition.

Petitioner is the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new regulated drain. The drainage will affect various lots in <u>Westoak Industrial Park</u> a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefitted thereby. Petitioner believes the proposed improvements will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the drainage system and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter.

The Petitioner also agrees to the following:

- 1. To provide the Drainage Board a Performance Bond for the portion of the drainage system which will be made a regulated drain. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Engineer's estimate. The bond will be in effect until construction of 100% of the system is completed and so certified by the Engineer.
- The Petitioner shall retain an Engineer throughout the construction phase.
   At completion of the project the Petitioner's Engineer shall certify that the drainage system which is to be maintained as a regulated drain has been constructed as per construction plans.
- 3. The Petitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All

changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain file.

- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The County Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures at Petitioners cost as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain as per IC 36-9-27-69(d).


