Re: Cool Creek Drain, 191st and Tomlinson Roundabout Reconstruction

Attached are petition, plans, and other information for the proposed reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, for the 191st and Tomlinson Road Roundabout Project. The reconstruction was petitioned by the City of Westfield. During the road reconstruction, the Cool Creek Drain will be affected and those changes are as follows:

Cool Creek Drain

The project will reconstruct a portion of Cool Creek Drain, with the placement of a new box culvert under the intersection of 191st Street and Tomlinson Road. The reconstruction will intercept the original open ditch channel at Sta. 63+41, per the original 1880 legal description, then run in a new channel through the new US 31 box culvert and intercept back at the original channel at Sta. 66+89. The new channel length will be 320 feet of open ditch. This is as shown on sheet 22 of the Road Plans for 191st Street and Tomlinson Road Roundabout construction plans, by USI Consultants, having preliminary plan date of November 6, 2012.

The total length of new drain shall be 320 feet. The 348 feet of original drain between Sta. 63+41 and Sta. 66+89 shall be vacated. This proposal will remove 28 feet from the Cool Creek Drain overall total length.

The cost of the reconstruction is to be paid by the City of Westfield

Since the petitioner is the City of Westfield and is being performed under public bid process, no bond is required for the relocation/reconstruction work.

The easement for this drain shall remain the existing statutory 75' from the centerline of the tile or the top of bank of the open ditch, as per IC 36-9-27-33. This reconstruction of the regulated drain will move the easement and work will be completed in the easement of the following parcels:

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the *Cool Creek*Drain, 191st and Tomlinson Road Roundabout Reconstruction came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on September 23, 2013, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the $Cool\ Creek\ Drain$, 191^{st} and $Tomlinson\ Road\ Roundabout\ Reconstruction$ be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

Attached are as-built, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for the 191st Street & Tomlinson Road Roundabout. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.


During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated August 2, 2013. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held September 23, 2013. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book15, Pages 183-185) The changes are as follows: the new open ditch, installed through a box culvert under the road, was shortened from 320 feet to 300 feet. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **300 feet**. It should be noted that the existing open ditch between Station 63+61 to Station 66+91 was removed with this project. Thus, 30 feet was removed from the drains' overall length.


The easements were outlined in my original report mentioned above. The easement will remain the statutory 75 feet per half. The project did not have sureties as it was completed and paid for by the City of Westfield.


I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
