

The surveyor's ditch repair record No. 1, page 200 gives a description of the John Wheeler ditch and provides that the ditch shall be of the original width at bottom and reads as follows:

From Station 0 to 158 "original width at bottom".

The Surveyor's ditch repair record No. 1, at page 5, gives a description of the John Beals-Grassy Branch-Ditch and provides that from Station 0 to Station 123 it was 3 ft. wide in bottom and from Station 123 to end of ditch 6 ft. wide in bottom.

Said Station O on the Beals ditch is the same as Station 159 on the Wheeler ditch, which means that from Station 159 to Station 282 it should be 3 ft. wide in the bottom and from Station 282 to end of ditch it should be 6 ft. wide in bottom.
