Re: Cool Creek Drain, Wehmeier Extension

Attached is a drain map for the Cool Creek Drain, Wehmeier Extension. This proposed drain is located in Washington Township.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

Open Ditch – 396 feet

The Cool Creek Drain, Wehmeier Extension shall begin at the east right of way of U.S. 31 which is the current terminus of the Cool Creek Drain, HG Kenyon & Harmon Clark Arm, per my report dated November 3, 2006 and approved by the Board at hearing on February 26, 2007 (See Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 10, Pages 103 to 105). Thence run downstream within the existing Cool Creek Tributary 396 feet to the confluence with Cool Creek on parcel 09-09-12-00-00-017.000, owned by Mary Wehmeier, Kurt Wehmeier, Julie Gilliam, Linda Mendell, and Dana Randall. The ending point is the Cool Creek Drain, Wheeler & Beals – John Beals Arm per the 1881 legal description (See Commissioner Records Book S, Pages 486 to 496).

The nature of maintenance work required is as follows:

- 1. Bank erosion protection and/or seeding as might be required;
- 2. Removal of debris and/or blockages from existing open drain;
- 3. Removal of beaver dams;
- 4. Any other repairs necessary to restore proper flow to the open ditch.

The frequency with which maintenance work should be performed is annually as required by the condition of the drain.

The easement for the drain on the parcels should be set at 75' from the top of bank as set out in IC 36-9-27-33. According to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map, Map Number 18057C0119F, the area for the Cool Creek Open Ditch is covered by the floodplain for Cool Creek. Therefore, I believe that no damages will result to landowners by the regulating of this drain.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, Wehmeier Extension be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
