Re: Cool Creek Drain, Oak Wood Arm

Upon Review of the drainage sheds I believe that the Oak Wood Drain should be made an arm to the Cool Creek Drain. I recommend this action as the Oak Wood Drain outlets into the Cool Creek Drain. This would also avoid a double assessment on the tracts currently assessed for the Oak Wood Drain when the remainder of the Cool Creek Drain is assessed for maintenance.

The Oak Manor Drain in Washington Township was placed on a maintenance program when it was developed. Surveyor's report for the Oak Wood Drain is dated December 10, 1986, and approved by the Board at a hearing on March 9, 1987 (Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 2, Pages 197 and 198). At present the Oak Wood Drain maintenance assessments affects 6 lots. The current rate of assessment for the Oak Wood Drain is \$5.00 per acre, \$50.00 minimum. These rates collect \$300.00 annually and the current balance in the maintenance fund is \$367.94. There are no outstanding work orders for this drain at this time.

The rates for the Cool Creek Drain have been set as follows:

- 1. Maintenance assessment for roads and streets be set at \$10.00 per acre with a \$25.00 minimum.
- 2. Maintenance assessment for agricultural tracts be set at \$2.00 per acres with a \$15.00 minimum.
- 3. Maintenance assessment for non-platted residential tracts be set at \$2.00 per acre with a \$15.00 minimum.
- 4. Maintenance assessment for commercial, institutional and multi-family residential tracts be set at \$35.00 per acre with a \$75.00 minimum.

- 5. Maintenance assessment for platted lots in subdivisions whose drainage systems will not be part of the regulated drain (those systems maintained by the Town of Westfield or City of Carmel) shall be set at \$25.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within non-regulated drain subdivisions shall be assessed at \$10.00 per acre with a \$25.00 minimum.
- 6. Maintenance assessment for platted lots within subdivisions whose drainage system will be part of the regulated drain shall be set at \$65.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within the regulated drain subdivisions shall be set at \$15.00 per acre with a \$65.00 minimum.

The tracts now assessed for the Oak Wood Drain should be assessed as platted lots within subdivisions whose drainage system is regulated drain, as set out in paragraph number 6 above.

When the original assessment roll was approved, Lot 1 (Parcel 08-10-07-00-01-001.000, currently owned by Jennifer Arthur) was not assessed to the Oak Wood Drain because it drains directly to Cool Creek. At this time, Lot 1 should be assessed to Cool Creek as set out in paragraph number 5 above, since the runoff does not utilize a regulated drain to get to the Cool Creek Regulated Drain.

The total annual assessment for this arm will be \$415.00.

The current balance of the Oak Wood Drain shall be kept separate and these funds expend for needed maintenance in the Oak Wood Subdivision on the drainage facilities that comprise the current Oak Wood Drain. This shall be done until the funds are exhausted. At that time funding for repairs shall then be taken from the Cool Creek Drain Fund.

Future assessments for the drainage area of the Oak Wood Drain will be made into the Cool Creek Drain fund. No further maintenance collections for the Oak Wood Drain fund shall be made.

I recommend that a hearing be held for this matter on November 26, 2007.



TO: Hamilton County Drainage Board

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans and assessment roll for the Oak Woods Drain.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accurring to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

880ft 6" Tile

420ft 8" Tile

400ft Open Ditch

The total length of the drain will be 1700 feet.

Although the drain is to run through tracts owned by Sumner and Franks, there will be no assessment for these tracts.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment fo \$50.00 per lot. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$300.00.
