27 of way of the Central Indiana Railroad Company and that
28 part extending through the north east quarter of section

1 one, township 18 north range 3 east, will be affected by
2 said proposed drainage.

3 Your petitioners would further represent and show
4 to the Court that the following streets in the town of
5 Westfield said County and State will be benefited and
6 affected by said proposed drainage, towit:- Elm, Park,
7 Maple, Poplar, Jersey and the south half of West Main
8 street in said town.

9 Your petitioners would further represent and show to
10 the court that they believe that the public health will
11 be improved and benefited by the proposed drainage, and
12 that the said proposed work will be of public utility.

13 Petitioners would further show and represent that
14 they believe the the proposed drainage can be accomplished
15 in the cheapest and best manner by a ditch and drain
16 beginning at a point six hundred and twenty six (626)
17 feet west and two hundred and ninty (290) feet south of
18 the north west corner of the north east quarter of section
19 one, township eighteen(18) north range three (3) east and
20 run thence in a southeasterly direction with the natural
21 drainage of said lands aforesaid, and terminating in what
22 is known as the Anna Kendall Ditch near the east line of
23 said section one.

24 And your petitioners would further represent and show
25 to the Court that they believe that the costs, damages
26 and expenses of such drainage will be less than the
27 benefits which will result to the owners of the lands
28 likely to be benefited thereby.

1 Wherefore your petitioners prays the court that said
2 ditch and drain may be established as provided by law.

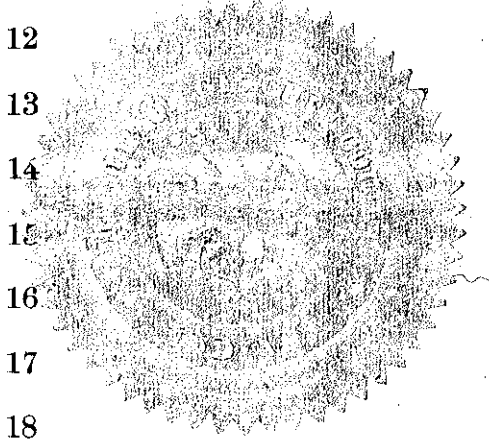

REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE Hamilton CIRCUIT COURT:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage, to whom was referred the petition of Goodrich Bros. Et-al for the drainage of the lands therein described in said petition, a certified copy of which is herewith attached being lands in Washington Township Hamilton County Ind. and Lots 1 East 2 Lot in the Town of Westfield Hamilton County Ind.

in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work, and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will be practicable and when constructed will improve the Public Health, and the Public Highways running East & West on Line between Sec. 36 and 1 - Township 19. & 18 - N. Range 3 East - also Elm St. - Park St. Maple St. Poplar St. Jersey St. in the town of Westfield Ind. and that said drainage will be of Public utility and that the cost, damages, and expenses of constructing said drainage will be less than the benefits to be obtained by lands & lots likely to be benefited thereby.

The best and cheapest method by which said drainage is by a main ditch and two tributaries as described on page - 6 - of this report.

They estimate the cost of constructing the work at \$ 822. ²⁰/₁₀₀

dollars. They further report that they have estimated the benefits and injury to the several tracts of land which will be affected by said work.
