Re: J.M. Thompson Drain

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the J.M. Thompson Drain. The relocation is being petitioned by Westfield Washington Schools.

The proposal is to intercept the storm sewer constructed along Union Street at MH 8. The length of the existing storm sewer between MH 8, MH 7, MH 6, and MH 5 which is 295', 45' and 265' of 68x43" RCP respectively for a total of 605 feet. This is shown on the plan prepared by Douglas E. Miller, P.E., dated January 10, 1990 sheet 3.

The new drain will continue south down the west line of Union Street to the intersection of Union and Hoover, thence turn west and run along the north line of Hoover Street to MH 5 as listed above. This will be between STR 73, STR 75, and STR 77 and will consist of 325 feet and 288 feet of 54" RCP between the structures for a total of 613 feet of drain. This is shown on plans prepared by Marchris/Moore Associates of Indiana dated September 20, 1995 for the Westfield Washington High School, sheets CE-21R3 and CE-27R3

Manhole 8 of the 1990 reconstruction is the same as STR 77 of the proposal and MH5 is the same as STR 73. This will add a total of 7 feet to the drain.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Westfield Washington Schools, because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioners property the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition. I recommend approval by the Board at this time.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 616ft. During the course of the relocation 605ft of original drain was removed. Thus, the total net length of drain is 11ft.


I recommend the Board approve the drains construction as complete and acceptable.
