Re: Anna Kendall Drain, U.S. 31 Reconstruction

Attached are petition, plans, and other information for the proposed reconstruction of the Anna Kendall Drain, for the U.S. 31 Road Project. The reconstruction was petitioned by the Indiana Department of Transportation. During the road reconstruction, the Anna Kendall Drain will be affected and those changes are as follows:

## Anna Kendall Drain

The project will reconstruct a portion of Anna Kendall Drain, with the placement of a new box culvert under US 31. The reconstruction will intercept the original open ditch channel at Sta. 137+86, per the original 1882 legal description, then run in a new channel through the new US 31 box culvert and intercept back at the original channel at Sta. 141+67. The new channel length will be 355 feet of open ditch. This is as shown on sheets 42 and 44 of the U.S. 31 Construction plans having project number 1296427, contract number IR-34750, and dated August 10, 2012.

The total length of new drain shall be 355 feet. The 381 feet of original drain between Sta. 137+86 and Sta. 141+67 shall be vacated. This proposal will remove 26 feet from the Anna Kendall overall total length.

The cost of the reconstruction is to be paid by the Indiana Department of Transportation.

Since the petitioner is the Indiana Department of Transportation and is being performed under public bid process, no bond is required for the relocation/reconstruction work.

The easement for this drain shall remain the existing statutory 75' from the centerline of the tile or the top of bank of the open ditch, as per IC 36-9-27-33. This reconstruction of the regulated drain will move the easement and work will be completed in the easement of the following parcels:

### FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **Anna Kendall Drain, U.S. 31 Reconstruction** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing **on May 28, 2013**, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the **Anna Kendall Drain**, **U.S. 31 Reconstruction** be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

Attached are as-builts and other information for the US 31 Reconstruction. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.


During construction, changes there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated February 28, 2013. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held May 28, 2013. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 15, Pages 6-7) Therefore, the length of the drain remains at **355 feet**. It should be noted that the project removed 381 feet of existing drain.

The project was constructed with in the limits of existing regulated drain easement and road right of way. The cost of the project was paid for by the Indiana Department of Transportation.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
