 Report of Survey of H. G. Kenyon Ditch,

Under the employ of H. G. Kenyon and preliminary to making application for the construction of a ditch under an act of the General Assembly approved March 13 1849, and entitled, An act to enable the owners of wet lands to drain and reclaim them when the same cannot be done without affecting the lands of others, &c; and in accordance with the 7<sup>th</sup> section of said act survey was made of the following described ditch:

Beginning <sup>852.5'</sup> 51 $\frac{2}{3}$  rods west of the south east corner of the north east quarter of the south east quarter of section 2 Township 18 north range 3 east, at a stake marked 0, running thence  
 from section stake 0 to section stake 11.40 South.

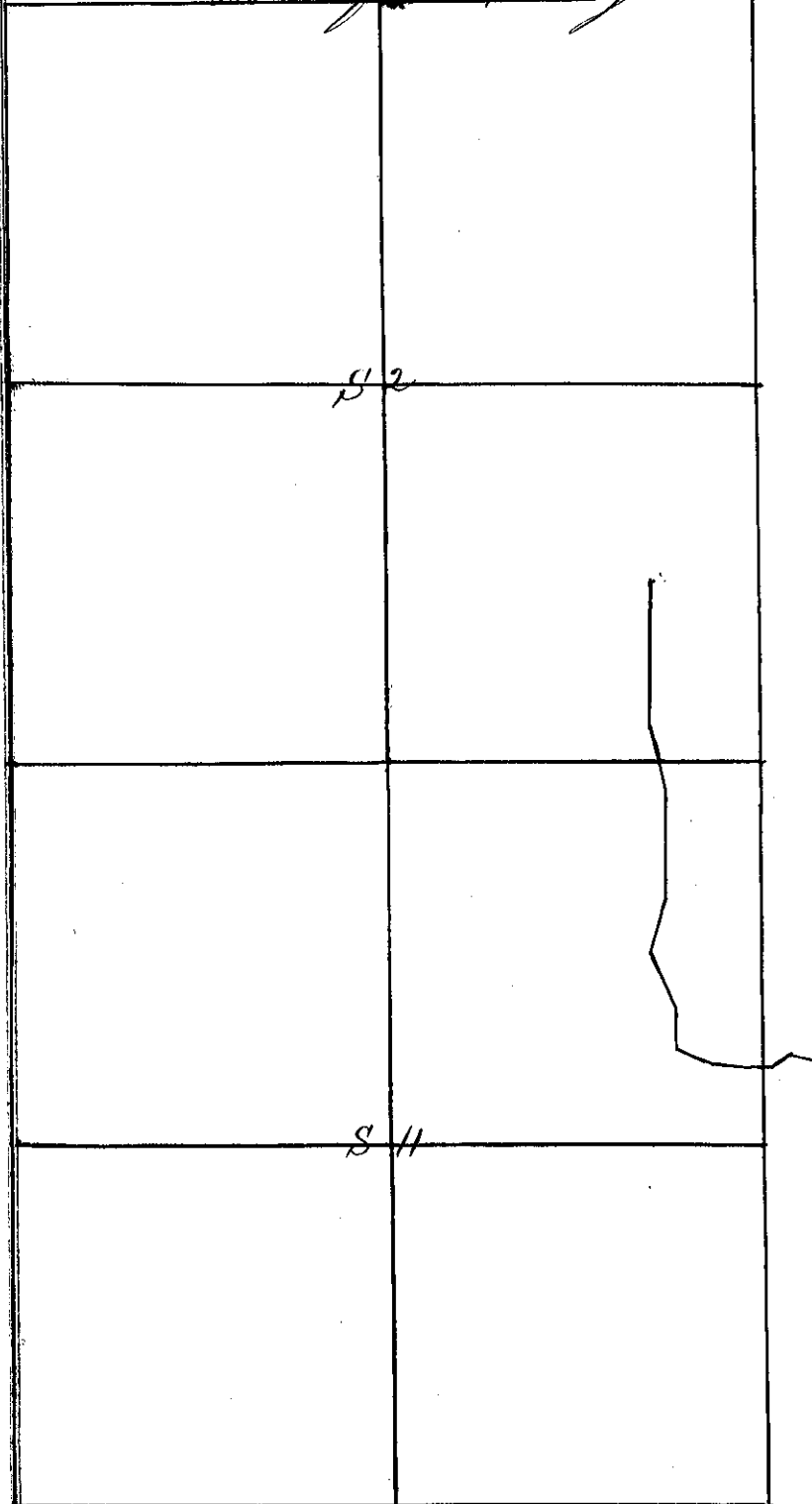
