

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Hills and Dales West Drain.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

The total length of the drain will be 5110 feet.

The open ditch portion of the drain listed above consists of that portion between the outlet of the 12" RCP under Corral Court to the inlet of the existing 15" CMP under Greyhound Pass. Also, the open ditch along the West side of the Monon Rail Road (abandoned) to the point, approximately 320 feet North of Greyhound Pass.

The SSD listed above are the lines under the curb for Corral Court. Only the main lines under the curb will be part of the regulated drains. Maintenance of the laterals will be the responsibility of the Homeowners.

The new storm sewer between Lots 31 and 38 of Village Farms Section 1 shall be regulated drain. Also, the existing 15" CMP under Greyhound pass shall also be part of the drain. The 15" pipe under the old Monon tract bed and the 12" pipe which connects the 15" pipe to the structure located on the property line of Lot 48, Village Farms, Section 1 shall also be part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$30.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$30.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be $f_{300} \rho_{20}$.

Lots 6,7 and 8 shall also be assessed for the Westfield Farms Drain. Block "A" shall not be assessed to the Hills and Dales West Drain, but shall remain assessed to the Westfield Farms Drain.

At a future date this drainage shed may also be assessed to the Overman-Harvey Drain.

The lakes shall not be a part of the regulated drain. The Board shall maintain the inlets into the lakes and the outlets from the lakes. The Board will retain the right to ensure no unauthorized structures or fill will be placed within the lakes or the lakes easement which will adversely affect the lakes capacity or function. The maintenance of the lake will be the Homeowners Associations or individual homeowners responsibility.

I recommend a hearing be set for May 1992. I also recommend to the Board that the attached non-enforcement be approved by the Board at the time of the hearing.

Petitioner is the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new regulated drain. The drainage will affect various lots in <u>Hills & Dales West</u> , a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Petetioner believes the proposed improvements will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the drainage system and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter.

The Petitioner also agrees to the following:

- 1. To provide the Drainage Board a Performance Bond for the portion of the drainage system which will be made a regulated drain. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Engineers estimate. The bond will be in effect until construction of 100% of the system is completed and so certified by the Engineer.
- 2. The Petitioner shall retain an Engineer throughout the construction phase. At completion of the project the Petitioner's Engineer shall certify that the drainage system which is to be maintained as a regulated drain has been constructed as per construction plans.

- ine retitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain File.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of 'the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The County Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures at Petitioners cost as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain.




