Attached is a petition, plans, non-enforcement request, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Village Farm Section 15 Arm, Overman Harvey drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSI	4,923	feet	18"	RCP	669	feet
12" RC	639	feet	21"	RCP	140	feet
15" RCI	970	feet	24"	RCP	215	feet
			30"	RCP	200	feet

The total length of the drain will be 7756 feet.

The retention pond (lake) located at the rear of Lots 656 to 668, 669 & Block A is not to be considered part of the regulated drain. Only the inlets will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the pond (lake) will be the responsibility of the Homeowners Association. The Board will however, retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the lake was designed will be retained. Thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated are those located under the curbs. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the Right-of Way are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. of \$10.00 per lot, \$1.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$10.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$ 46000.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the secondary plat for Village Farms Section 15 as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for July 1997.

Petitioner is the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new regulated drain. The drainage will affect various lots in Village Farms, Section Fifteen, a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Petitioner believes the proposed improvement will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the drainage system and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter. The Petitioner also agrees to the following:

1. To provide the Drainage Board a Performance Bond for the portion of the drainage system which will be made a regulated drain. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Engineers estimate. The bond will be in effect until construction of 100% of the system is completed and so certified by the Engineer.

- 2. The Petitioner shall retain the Engineer throughout the construction phase. At completion of the project the Petitioners Engineer shall certify that the drainage system which is to be maintained as a regulated drain has been constructed as per construction plans.
- 3. The Petitioner shall request all changes from the approved plan prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain file.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain.


