Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Springmill Ponds Drain-Section 5
I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD 3488 ft 21" RCP 430 ft 12" RCP 179 ft 24" RCP 180 ft 15" RCP 37 ft 27" RCP 140 ft

The total length of the drain will be 4454 feet.

The subsurface drains (SSD) shown above includes the 6" SSD under the curbs and the SSD in the rear of the following lots: 153 to 157; 159, 160, 185 to 187 and 190 to 200. Only the main subsurface drain will be maintained. The laterals off the main line are private drains and will not be maintained as part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$25.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$25.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$675.00.

Parcels assessed for this drain may be assessed for the Collins-Osborn or Williams Creek sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for January 1993, also recommend the Board approve the attached non-enforcement request at the time of hearing if the petition is approved.

- 3. The Petitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain File.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. 




