Re: Cool Creek Drain - Springmill Villages Arm, 156th Street & Springmill Road - Roundabout

Attached are petition, plans, and other information for the proposed reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain – Springmill Villages Arm, for the 156th Street and Springmill Road Roundabout project. The reconstruction was petitioned by the City of Westfield. During this reconstruction, the Cool Creek Drain – The Crossings – Section 1B Arm or the Springmill Villages Arm will be affected. Those changes are as follows:

Cool Creek Drain

Cool Creek Drain – The Crossings Section 1B Arm to the Springmill Villages Arm: The project will remove 203 feet of 12" RCP from Str. 139 running west to Str. 140 and moving Str. 130 east 10 feet, by removing 10 feet of 12" RCP. This is shown on Sheets 9 and 16 of the plans prepared by A&F Engineering, Inc., having contract number 36438, project number 1173468 and dated April 28, 2014.

The road project will remove 213 feet of the Cool Creek Drain, The Crossings Section 1B Arm of the Springmill Villages Arm.

The cost of the reconstruction is to be paid by the City of Westfield.

Since the petitioner is the City of Westfield and is being performed under public bid process, no bond is required for the relocation/reconstruction work.

On this 24th day of November, 2014, the Hamilton County Drainage Board has held a hearing on the Maintenance Report and Schedule of Assessments of the Cool Creek Drain, Springmill Villages Arm, 156th Street & Springmill Road Roundabout - The Crossings Section 1B, removing 203 Ft. of 12" RCP from Structure 139 to Structure 140 and moving Structure 130 east 10 Ft.

Evidence has been heard. Objections were presented and considered. The Board then adopted an order of action. The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Cool Creek Drain, Springmill Villages Arm, 156th Street & Springmill Road Roundabout - The Crossings Section 1B, removing 203 Ft. of 12" RCP from Structure 139 to Structure 140 and moving Structure 130 east 10 Ft.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, Springmill Villages Arm, 156th Street & Springmill Road Roundabout came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on November 24, 2014, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, Springmill Villages Arm, 156th Street & Springmill Road Roundabout be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

The Board issued an order declaring the proposed improvement established. Such findings and order were marked filed and are available for inspection in the Office of the Hamilton County Surveyor.



Re: Cool Creek Drain: Springmill Villages Arm – 156th & Springmill Rndbt.

Attached are a map and other information for the Springmill Villages $Arm - 156^{th}$ & Springmill Roundabout. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated October 7, 2014. (See DRB. 16, Pages 19-22.) Therefore, the length of the drain removed remains at **-213 feet**.

Drainage easements were not affected as all work was done within existing road right of way and the project was paid for by the City of Westfield.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
