(See Drainage Board Minutes Book 16, Pages 131-132) **It should be noted that this final report covers only the Sun Communications Business Park Arm covered in my initial report. A separate final report was written for the Westfield Business Park Arm. The changes to the drain are as follows: the existing pipe between existing structures 707 to 708 was not replaced as originally planned. Existing structure 708 was replaced with new structure 7928. The 12" RCP was shortened in length from 155 feet to 68 feet. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **68 feet**.

The work was completed with existing regulated drain easement and or road right of way. The work was paid for by the Indiana Department of Transportation.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
