Re: County McMahon Drain, New Life Assembly of God Arm

Attached is a 52.5 petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the County McMahon Drain. The relocation is being proposed by New Life Assembly of God. The proposal is to relocate the drain across parcel #10-07-19-00-00-031.001 owned by New Life Assembly of God Church as part of the New Life Assembly of God project per plans by Falcon Engineering, Job No. 219.0, revision date April 22, 2007.

Per plans the storm water will be routed through the New Life Assembly of God site from the west side of the site, Tract 10-07-19-00-00-031.001, thence, draining in a southeasterly direction and tie into the existing drain on the south property line of said tract. This will occur between Structures 802, 801, 800 and 700 as shown on the attached plans.

The line will consist of the following:

18" A2000 HDPE 496 ft.

The total length of the new drain shall be 496 feet. The 392 feet of original drain between Station 7+39 and 11+31 shall be vacated. This proposal will add 104 feet to the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by New Life Assembly of God. The developer has provided the Letter of Credit as follows:

Attached is a non-enforcement request. The easement for the new drain will be 15' per half (30' total) between Structures 800, 801 and 802; and 55' total between Structures 700 and 800 per the attached plans. I recommend approval of the non-enforcement by the Board.

I recommend that this drain be classified as an urban drain.

The project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition.

hereby petitions the	Hamilton County Drainage Board for au	thority to relocate and improve a
section of the	County-McMahon Regulated	Drain, and in support of
said petition advises	the Board that:	

- 1. Petitioner owns real estate through which a portion of the <u>County-McMahon Regulated</u> Drain runs.
- 2. Petitioner plans to develop its real estate with roads, buildings, utilities, storm drains, sanitary sewers and other structures.
- Petitioner's proposed development of its real estate will require relocation and reconstruction of a portion of the <u>County-McMahon Regulated</u> Drain, as specifically shown on engineering plans and specifications filed with the Hamilton County Surveyor.
- 4. The work necessary for the proposed relocation and reconstruction will be undertaken at the sole expense of the Petitioner and such work will result in substantial improvement to the <u>County-McMahon Regulated</u> Drain, without cost to other property owners on the watershed of the <u>County-McMahon Regulated</u> Drain.
- 5. Proposed relocation and reconstruction will not adversely affect other land owners within the drainage shed.
- Petitioner requests approval of the proposed relocation and reconstruction under IC 36-9-27-52.5.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests that an Order issued from the Hamilton County Drainage Board authorizing relocation and reconstruction of the <u>County-McMahon Regulated</u> Drain, in conformance with applicable law and plans and specifications on file with the Hamilton County Surveyor.

- 2. That as property owners within the drainage shed, they are qualified petitioners.
- 4. The names ad address of each owner affected by the proposed public drainage are attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked Exhibit "A", which area of land involved in the proposed drainage area is located in section 19, township 19 N north, range 5 east, Hamilton County, Indiana.

5. That the proposed reconstruction consists of <u>Relocating the</u> <u>And VeconStruction</u> by the county to the outlet

- 6. That in the opinion of the Petitioner, the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land to be benefited thereby.
- 7. That in the opinion of the Petitioner, the proposed improvement will improve the public health; benefit a public highway; and be of public utility.
- 8. That Petitioners shall pay the cost of notice and all legal costs including engineering expense if the petition is dismissed.
- 9. Petitioners shall post a bond, if required, to pay the cost of notice and all legal costs in the case the improvement is not established.

Re: County McMahon Drain: New Life Assembly of God Relocation

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for New Life Assembly of God Relocation. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated June 11, 2008. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held June 23, 2008. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 11, Pages 216-217) The changes are as follows:

The 18" A2000 HDPE was shortened from 496 feet to 481 feet.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **481 feet**. The original drain was vacated between Sta. 7+33 to Sta.11+18. This removed 385' of 18" tile. Therefore, this project added 96 feet of drain to the watershed.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on June 23, 2008and recorded under instrument #2008037254.

The following sureties were guaranteed by India Members Credit Union and released by the Board on its April 13, 2009 meeting.


