Re: R. J. Craig Drain, George White Arm, Maple Street Reconstruction

Attached are plans for the proposed reconstruction of the R. J. Crain Drain, George White Arm No. 3. The proposal is to replace the drain in the Maple Street right-of-way, owned by the Town of Fishers per the 'R. J. Craig Regulated Drain Reconstruction - Maple Street' project plans by A&F Engineering, Job No. AF-14039P, dated 6/5/2014.

Per the plans, a portion of the existing drain will be replaced by a new storm sewer.

This line will consist of the following pipes:

141' of 12" RCP

278' of 15" RCP

90' of 18" RCP

The total length of the new reconstructed drain shall be 509 feet, including new pipe and structures. The 318 feet of original drain between Sta. 0+00 and 3+18 shall be vacated. This proposal will add 191 feet to the drain's total length.

The original drain was previously referenced in my report for the 1997 reconstruction of the George White Arm 3 that was approved at hearing by the Board on November 27, 1997 as recorded in Drainage Board Minutes Book 4 page 482. Note: The drain immediately downstream of this project is also proposed for reconstruction at this time. See my report called "R. J. Craig Drain, George White Arm, Fishers Maple Street Redevelopment" for more information on that project.

This proposal includes the drain route between storm structures 36, 201, 202, 203, 204, 206, 207, and 208 per the A&F plans. (Note: Str. 205 is called out on the plans as a pipe stub to Str. 204 for future tie-in, but is not to be considered part of the regulated drain). The new drain pipe shall be located between A&F Sta. 16+06.00 (Str. 36) and 20+60.72 (Str. 208). This includes the main trunk line that runs along the east side of Maple Street and two pipes that cross Maple Street (Str. 202-203 and 204-206).

The fund is assessed at \$5.00 per acre, \$25.00 minimum which brings in \$40,678.70 annually. Currently the R. J. Craig maintenance fund has a balance of \$151,685.30 the engineering contract for the design of this project by A & F Engineering is \$21,570.00. After payment of his claim the fund balance will be \$144,451.30. The engineer's cost estimate for the project is \$163,150.87.

I believe there are three funding options for the Board to consider:

- 1. Use the existing maintenance fund for the cost of the project taking the \$18,699.57 short fall out of the General Drain Improvement Fund (GDIF) to be paid back using 2015 collections.
- 2. Take 75% of the maintenance fund under IC 36-9-27-45.5 which is \$108,338.48 and fund the remaining \$54,812.39 through a reconstruction assessment for those properties benefited on Maple Street. The assessment would be \$28,400.20 per acre.
- 3. Take the entire maintenance fund and fund the \$18,699.57 short fall through a reconstruction assessment on those properties on Maple Street benefitting which would be an assessment of \$9,673.35 per tract.

The reconstruction will take place in the drain's current location, no additional easement is required. Where the drain is being extended on the north end of the project, a grant of easement will be submitted on the Meyer-Najem project currently under review.

I recommend that this drain be classified as an urban drain.

I recommend the Board set a hearing date for July 28, 2014.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the R. J. Craig Drain, George White Arm, Maple Street Reconstruction be and is hereby declared established.

Re: RJ Craig Drain: George White Arm - Maple Street Reconstruction

Attached are as-built, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for the George White Arm-Maple Street Reconstruction which is a reconstruction of the George White Arm 3. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with the original Surveyor's report for this drain dated June 9, 2014. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held July 28, 2014. (See Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 15, Pages 482-485)

The changes are as follows:

12" RCP was shortened from 141 feet to 102 feet.

15" RCP was shortened from 278 feet to 277 feet.

18" RCP was shortened from 90 feet to 83 feet.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 462 feet. As noted in the original Surveyor's Report dated June 9, 2014 the original 12" tile was removed from Station 0 to Sta. 3+18. Therefore, this project adds 144 feet to the drains overall length.

The reconstruction was completed by Rieth Riley Construction Company Inc. who was under contract with the City of Fishers. The project was completed through thru an Inter-local Agreement between the Hamilton County Drainage Board and the City of Fishers dated December 10, 2014 and was paid for with maintenance funds. (See Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 15, Pages 574)

The payments to the City of Fishers are as follows:

Claim Date: January 27, 2015 June 28, 2016 Claim number:Claim Amount:Pay Request # 1\$111,751.22Pay Request # 2 (Retainage)\$19,720.80

At this time all claims for the reconstruction have been paid to the City of Fishers. The contractor has submitted a statement that all expenses incurred for labor and materials have been paid in full as required per IC 36-9-27-82.

The project estimate on my original report dated June 9, 2014 was \$163,150.87. The contract price was a lump sum payment to Fishers in the amount of \$131,472.02. During the course of this work no change orders were issued for the reconstruction. Therefore, the total project cost was \$131,472.02.

As of the date of this report, I hereby attest to and agree that the reconstruction was completed according to the specified plans and have approved such work under IC-36-9-27-82(a).

I recommend the Board approve the drain's reconstruction as complete and acceptable.

A RESOLUTION OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD RELINQUISHING JURISDICTION OVER A PORTION OF A REGULATED DRAIN

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Drainage Board, ("the Drainage Board"), currently has jurisdiction over the George White Arm of the R.J. Craig Drain, a portion of which is located within the City of Fishers, Hamilton County, Indiana ("Fishers"); and,

WHEREAS, Fishers has petitioned the Drainage Board, to relinquish the Drainage Board's jurisdiction over a portion of the George White Arm of the R.J. Craig Drain ("the Relinquished Drain") as described on Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made apart hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the Drainage Board has the authority to relinquish its jurisdiction over drains located in a municipality if that jurisdiction is accepted by the municipality pursuant to Indiana Code 36-9-27-20; and,

WHEREAS, Fishers has agreed to accept any and all duties to maintain, construct, reconstruct, and relocate the Relinquished Drain.

IT IS THEREBY RESOLVED by the Drainage Board as follows:

- The Drainage Board relinquishes jurisdiction to maintain, construct, reconstruct, and relocate the portion of the Relinquished Drain described in Exhibit A.
- 2. Because the Relinquished Drain will continue to discharge water into the R.J. Craig Drain, all real estate served by the Relinquished Drain, shall continue to pay the full maintenance assessments of the Drainage Board which are assessed for the maintenance of the remaining portion of the R.J. Craig Drain.

3. This Resolution to transfer jurisdiction over the Relinquished Drain, shall be effective upon acceptance of the duties transferred by this Resolution by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Fishers.

ROAD PLANS MAPLE STREET POST CONSTRUCTION ASBUILTS



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
TYPICAL SECTION Sta. 15+04.66 "PR-B" to Sta. 15+17.73 "PR-B"




TYPICAL SECTION
Sta. 10+24.23 "PR-B" to Sta. 15+04.66 "PR-B"





