On October 14, 1987 an inspection was made on the relocation of the above referenced drain. Present was Stan Neal, Weihe Eng.; Dave Childs, D.R. Childs Inc.; Kurt Woerner, Town of Fishers; Jerry Liston and myself. At that time the project was found to be complete and acceptable.

This work was completed as the remedial work necessary due to a violation to Mr. Terry Hiles dated 12-19-85. The work was paid for by Mr. Hiles. The reconstruction report to the Board is dated 06-05-87.

Attached are asbuilt plans showing the new location. Note should be made that the tile entering MH#1 from the north on the attached plan is actually in the east wall of the structure and "T" into the tile from the east.

This reconstruction eliminated the James Bradburn Drain from Sta. 0 to the existing inlet at approximately Sta. 1+50. The drain remains in operation from Sta. 1+50 (existing inlet on Lot 7 of Kimberlands Addition to the Town of Fishers) to the manhole in the intersection of the alley running east and west between Moore Street and Lantern Road and the alley running north and south between 116th Street and South Street which is shown as Sta. 2+45 on the asbuilt plan. This length is approximately 25 feet.

This work also eliminated a section of the George White Drain. The section from Station 0+25 to Sta. 1+90 is now abandoned. The section from Sta. 0+00 to Sta. 0+25 is still active. The tile shown on the asbuilt print running north out of proposed manhole #1 along the west side of Lantern Road is an existing 12". This tile is not part of the regulated drain.

I recommend the Board accept this work as complete.
