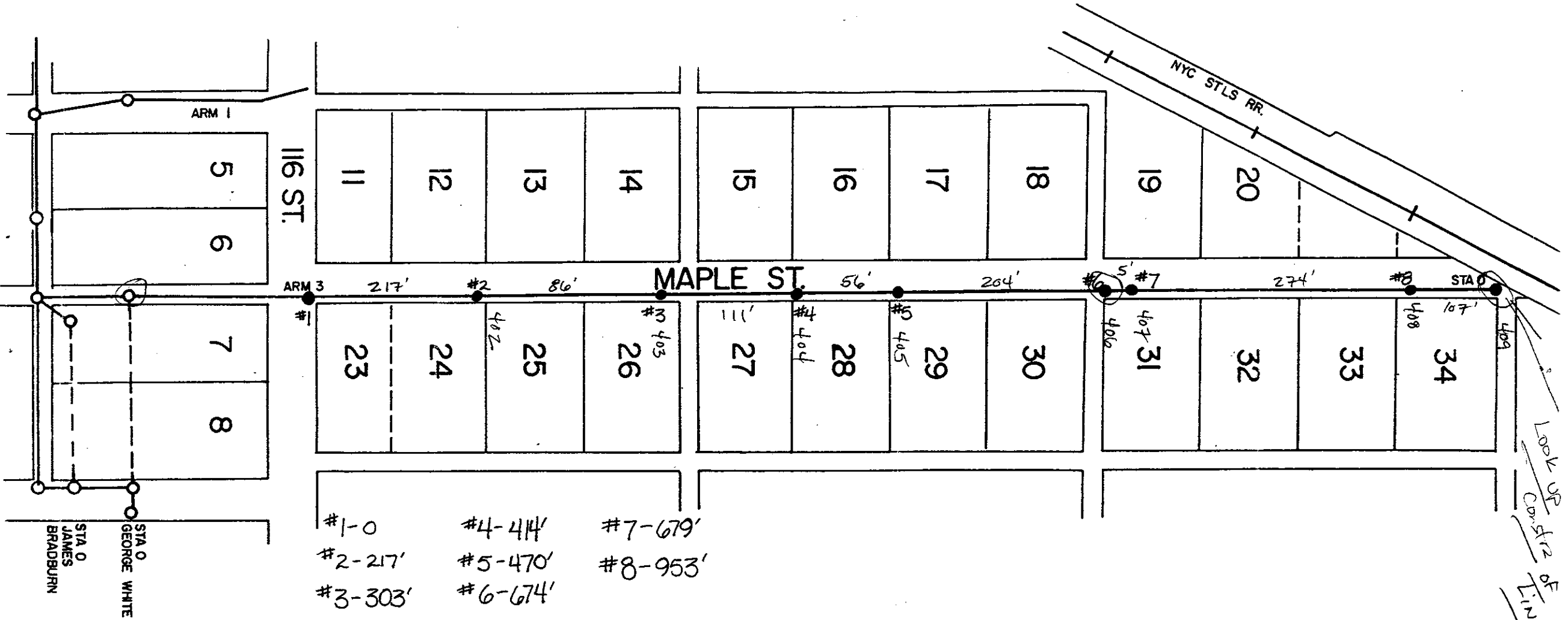

Arm No. 2 begins 10 feet west and 160 feet north of the southwest corner of Lot No 3 of the original plat of Fishers, Indiana, and runs south 325 feet and enters into the main ditch at station 5 plus 5 feet at the catch basin.

**Specifications.**  
 Said ditch to be tiled from station 0 to station 36 plus 60 feet on the main ditch with twenty (20) inch drain tile, Arm No. 1 to be tiled from station 0 to station 1 plus 54 feet with ten (10) inch drain tile, and Arm No. 2 to be tiled from station 0 to station 3 plus 25 feet with eight (8) inch drain tile except as otherwise specified at catch basins, retaining wall, etc. where sewer pipe are used instead at station 0, 7 plus 50 feet, 3 plus 40 feet, 5 plus 5 feet and

five (25) feet south and fifteen (15) feet east of the  
north east corner of section 7, Township 17 north, range  
4 east, and run thence south 87 degrees west, 500 feet;  
thence south 62 degrees west, 180 feet; thence south, 320 ft  
thence south 12 degrees east, 200 feet, thence south, 2000  
feet; thence south 13 degrees west, 200 feet; thence south 26  
degrees west, 260 feet and terminating in what is known  
as the R. J. Craig Drain at a point 430 feet south and 775  
feet west of the north east corner of the southeast quarter  
of said section 7.

Arm No 7 begins 10 feet south of the southeast corner  
of Lot No, 3 of the original plat of Fishers, Indiana,  
and runs south 14 degrees east, 40 feet; thence  
south, 114 feet and enters into the main ditch at  
station 3 plus 60 feet, with a trifid "y" connection.
