Re: Lydia Crawford Drain

Attached is a drain map, drainage shed map and assessment roll for the Lydia Crawford Drain. This drain is both open and tile and is located in section 32, township 20 North, range 5 East in White River Township. The drain was constructed in 1884 by order of the Commissioners and is 3,778 feet in length. The drain has several holes in the tile which needs repair and also the outlet needs to be opened as shown on the attached profile. I believe that this work can be done on a maintenance program.

There are 123.50 acres in the drainage shed. Because of the amount of work needed on the outlet, I believe that the first years assessment should be set at \$8.00 per acre with a minimum of \$20.00. This will bring in \$1,004.00 the first year. The assessment thereafter should then be set at \$2.00 per acre, \$6.00 minimum. Which will generate a yearly assessment of \$252.00.

I recommend a hearing for maintenance be set for 1:35 P.M. on February 7, 1983.
