

To Honorable, H. L. Findley, Surveyor of Hamilton County, Indiana:

Whereas, George Anthony having filed a petition in the office of the Auditor of Hamilton County, Indiana, and it appearing from the statements therein that said drain if extended and established will not exceed, when completed, two miles in length, and will not cost to exceed \$300,00 exclusive of the cost of the tile that may be used therein, and that you, as such surveyor, are not in any manner interested in said drain, and not related to any of the parties likely to be assessed for the construction thereof, the same is, therefore, hereby referred to you and you are hereby ordered to investigate and report to me on said drain within thirty (30) days from this date, and in so doing you shall have all the duties and powers granted to engineers, drainage commissioners and viewers as by law provided.

The undersigned, your petitioner would respectfully represent and show that he is the owner of the south west quarter of Section 32, in Township 20 north of range 4 east, in Hamilton County, Indiana, and that said lands will be benefited by extension and tiling of what is known as the "C. P. Scherer Drain", from Station 21 plus 70, as shown in the plans and profile of said drain, in a south-westerly direction to Hinkle Creek, and that said ditch may be made more efficient and more economically kept in repair by such extension and tiling thereof.

That the extension and tiling of said ditch, as hereinbefore set out, would make the same of public utility, the public health would thereby be improved and that the public highway on the west line of Section 32, township 20 north, of Range 4 east, in said County, will be benefited thereby.

That it is the belief of your petitioner that said C. P. Scherer Drain, can be best and more economically improved by extending the same from said station 21 plus 70 in a southwesterly direction to said Hinkle Creek, and the tiling thereof with tile of sufficient capacity to carry water accumulating on the lands drained by said ditch; that the costs, expenses and damages of such extension and drainage will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of lands and other properties and easements, likely to be effected thereby.

That said extension and improvement of said drain, with with all of its branches , will not exceed two miles in length, and will not cost to exceed three hundred dollars exclusive of the tile that may be used therein; that the Surveyor, Honorable F. L. Findley, of said County, is not interested therein, and that he , the said surveyor, is not related to the parties, or any of them, likely to be effected thereby.

That the following described lands will be benefited by the extension, construction and tiling of said drain as hereinbefore set out; viz;

The south west quarter of the north west quarter of Section 32 in township 20 north, of Range 4 East, except five acres off of the north end thereof, and said described lands belonging to Albert Ross.

The south east quarter of the north west quarter of Section 32 township 20 north, of range 4, east, and being 25 acres more or less off of the south side of said south east quarter of said north west quarter section, and owned by Mary J. Kist.

A part of the west half of the north west quarter of section 32 township 20 north, of range 4 east, and a part of the south west quarter of the north west quarter of said said section 32, the same being 45 acres off of the north end of the west half of the said north west quarter of said said section 32, and owned by Wilson Reagan.

The north east quarter of the north east quarter and the south east quarter of the north east quarter of section 31 township 20 north, of range 4 east, owned by Alfred Johnson,

The south west quarter of the south west quarter of section 29 township 20 north, of range 4 east, owned by Rutha McCarty.

The south east quarter of the south east quarter of section 30 township 20 north, of range 4 east, belonging to W. W. McCarty.

The north east quarter of ^{the North East quarter} of Section Thirty (30) in township twenty (20) north, of range four (4) east, east, belonging to unknown.

The east half of the west half of the south east quarter of section 30, township 20, north, of range 4 east, belonging to William Mallott.

The north east quarter of the south west quarter, and the south east quarter of the south west quarter of Section 30, in township 20 north, of range 4 east, owned by Jesse Kellam and Rachel A. Kellam.

The west half of the west half of the south east quarter of section 30, in township 20, north, of range 4 east, belonging to Jesse Kellam.

The north west quarter of the south west quarter and the south west quarter of the south west quarter, all in section 30, in township 20 north, of range 4 east, owned by Harrison Jones.

That part of the north west quarter ~~north west quarter~~ of section 31 township 20 north of range 4 east, owned by Albert L. Hiatt, and being 92 acres more or less, off of the north end of said north west quarter of said section.

A part of the north ~~east~~ quarter of section 31, township 20 north of range 4 east, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the north east corner of the west half of said north east quarter section, and run thence west 34 rods; south 104 rods; east 34 rods; north 104 rods to place of beginning, belonging to Emma J. Davis. 22, Acres

A part of the north east quarter of section 31, township 20 north, of range 4 east, described and bounded as follows; commencing 34 rods west of the north east corner of the west half of said quarter section, and run thence west 20 rods; south 104 rods; east 20 rods to place of beginning, 18 acres, owned by Mary E. Baker.

A part of the north west quarter of the north east quarter of section 31, township 20 north, of range 4 east, described as follows, commencing 54 rods west of the north east corner of the west half of said north east quarter, and run west to west line of said section; thence south 104 rods; thence east to the south east corner of the lands of Mary E. Baker, 16 1/2 acres owned by Thomas C. Wilson.

A part of the west half of the north east quarter of Section 31, township 20 north, of range 4 east, described as follows to-wit: Commencing at the south east corner of of the west half of said north east quarter of said section 31, and run thence west, 28 rods and six feet; thence north 56 rods; thence east 28 rods and six feet; thence south to place of beginning, containing 9 80/100 acres, and belonging to Alvin Foulke.

A part of the south half of the west half of the north ¹/₂ of the north east quarter of section 31, township 20, north, of range 4 east, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing 28 rods and 6 feet east of the south east corner of the west half of said north east quarter section, and run west

to the west line of said quarter section; thence north 56 rods; thence east to a point 28 rods and six feet east of west line of the east half of said quarter section; thence south to the place of beginning, owned by Sarah N. Fulton.

The north east quarter of the south east quarter of section 31, township 20, north of range 4 east belonging to

Thomas Baker

The south west quarter of the south west quarter and the north west quarter of the south west quarter of Section 32 in township 20 north, of range 4 east, belonging to George Anthony.

Petitioner also believes that the Jackson township public highway running east and west between sections 30 and 31 and sections 29 and 32 in township 20 north, of range 4 east and the public highway on the line dividing sections 30 & 29 and sections 31 and 32, north and south, in said township and range, will be materially benefited thereby.

Wherefore your petitioner, prays that said ditch be extended, constructed and tiled in the manner herein before set out and herein prayed for.
