

Attached is a petition for Partial relocation of the Jacob Ehman Drain. This petition was filed by Dave Dodd for the relocation of the tile drain on Parcel Number 01-01-12-00-00-006.008.003. This is to be done on the Petitioners property at the Petitioners expense.

The relocation will consists of rerouting approximately 310 feet of the Arm #1 to Arm #1 of the Jacob Ehman Drain. This is to be done per attached plan as prepared by Miller Surveying. The relocation will consist of 384 feet of 12" concrete tile with risers at both ends of the new tile , where it intersects with the original. This will add approximately seventy-four (74') feet to the drain. Petitioner has submitted a bond for this work.

Because this work is being done on the petitioner's property at his expense and abutting properties will not be adversely affected by construction nor additional easement I believe the project falls under the provisions of IC 36-9-27-52.5. I therefore recommend approval of this petition.

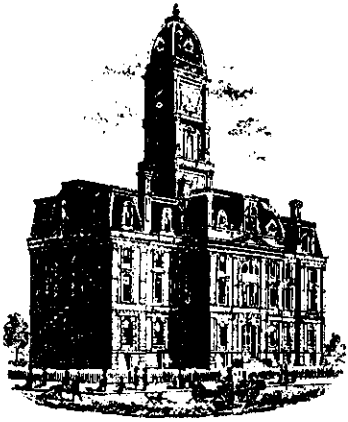

During construction, changes were made to the drain which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain dated May 27, 1997. The changes are as follows:  
Str1-2 12" Concrete Tile lengthened from 384' feet to 402' feet.


The additional length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **92' feet**.
