REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS.

To the Honorable Judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage, to whom was referred the petition of John Rushton Olga Rushton for the drainage of 20 acres off the South End of E 1/2 North East quarter Section 1 Township 20 North of Range 3 East

in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work, and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will be practicable, ^{will} improve the public health of that neighborhood, will be of public utility, and that the same can be constructed at an expense less than the aggregate benefits to the lands to be affected thereby. And after causing the necessary surveys and examinations to be made are of the opinion that the method of drainage should be as follows, to wit: By the construction of a tile ditch beginning at the SW corner of E 1/2 N E 1/4 Sec 1, T 20 N, R. 3 E and run thence N 58 E 250ft S 53 E 525ft N 80 1/2 E 425ft S 71 E 150ft S 11 W 150ft S 17 W 100ft S 11 W 100ft S 8 E 100ft S 75 E 100ft S 85 E 116ft and terminate 30 rods South & 1 rod east of the North East corner of South East quarter Section 1, T 20 N, R. 3 E. in and with a tile ditch already constructed being a prong of the Jacob Shuman ditch

They estimate the cost of constructing the work at \$125 dollars. They further report that they have estimated the benefits and injury to the
