

Attached is a plot plan and schedule of assessment for the proposed Elliot Creek Drain. This drain is proposed as part of the platting of the Village of WestClay. The portion to be regulated at this time is that portion through the proposed Village of WestClay. All easements are to be as per the proposed plats for the development. The developer is improving the open ditch as part of the development's construction.

The drain shall consist of 1,336 feet of open ditch. This length is from 131st Street, North side of right of way, to the East property line of tract 17-09-28-00-00-027.000. The cost for maintenance should be set at \$3.00 acre, \$15.00 minimum. Damage shall be set at \$0.00.

Hearing for this proposal shall be set for July 26, 1999.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the *Elliot Creek Drain* came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on *July 26, 1999*, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objections of owners of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owners being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and , upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the ~~Spring Mill Run~~ *Elliot Creek* Drain be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
