Re: Geistview Estates Drain

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement requests, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment rolls for the Geistview Estates Drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

> SSD 880 ft 20 ft

The total length of the drain will be 900 feet.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated drain are those located along the east side of the lots. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the easement are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$100.00 per lot, \$10.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$100.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$600.00.

Parcels assessed for this drain may be assessed for the Fall Creek Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those widths as shown on the secondary plat for Geistview Estates as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for September 25, 2000.

Petitioner is the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new regulated drain. The drainage will affect various lots in GEISTWYEW ESTATES, a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Petetioner believes the proposed improvements will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the drainage system and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter.

The Petitioner also agrees to the following:

- 1. To provide the Drainage Board a Performance Bond for the portion of the drainage system which will be made a regulated drain. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Engineers estimate. The bond will be in effect until construction of 100% of the system is completed and so certified by the Engineer.
- The Petitioner shall retain an Engineer throughout the construction phase. At completion of the project the Petitioner's Engineer shall certify that the drainage system which is to be maintained as a regulated drain has been constructed as per construction plans.

- 3. The Petitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain File.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The County Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures at Petitioners cost as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain.

Re: Geistview Estates Drain

Attached are plans and other information for Geistview Estates Drain. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated August 14, 2000. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 5, Pages 461-3) The changes are as follows:

The 6" SSD was shortened from 880 feet to 845 feet. Only on riser was located in the field and that was on the north line of lot 2. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 845 feet.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on September 25, 2000 and recorded under instrument #20000061201. The following sureties were guaranteed by Community Bank and expired on July 7, 2001.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
