The report of the viewers was favorable and was filed. Report of R. D. Horney, County Surveyor, who was appointed to supervise the construction of the above drain, would respectfully report that he has made a survey of the above drain and did proceed and definitely determine the best and cheapest method of drainage, the terminal and route, location, character of the proposed work, and fix the same by notes and bounds, courses and distances and description, including grades and bench marks, including all necessary arms, estimated the cost thereof, divided the drain or ditch into sections of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section, assessed the benefits or damages, as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the water shed to be affected thereby and to easements held by rail roads or other public or private corporations or towns, including any land rights, easements of water power, injuriously or beneficial affected, and do make report to the court under oath.

LOCATION Begin approximately 20 rods East and 20 rods South of the Northwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter, Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 5 East; thence in a North and Northeasterly direction follow tile ditch now in place approximately  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles East and  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles South of Cicero, Indiana

RECOMMENDATIONS Construct 300 lin. ft.  $\frac{1}{2}$  or - 16" tile. Begin - at the open inlet approximately 300 feet South of Highway running East - and West, thence in a Northerly direction on or along the line of old - tile ditch now in place.

Repair open inlet.

There are 2 or 3 or more broken places in tile running from East and West Road in a Northeasterly direction to be inspected and repair what is required. Approximately 50 lin. ft.  $\frac{1}{2}$  or - of tile required. Contractor to bid the work on a unit basis for a complete job. There is one large hole that will require extra dirt. The contractor shall fill over tile to approximately 2.0' covering and Mr. Gilkey will finish filling the hole at his own expense. Any fences required to be moved and replaced shall be done at the expense of the contractor. All work to be done in a neat and workmanlike manner.

That the petitioners are the owners of more than ten (10) per cent of the land that will be affected by the proposed drain.

That said real estate lies entirely without the corporate limits of any city or town.

That said above described real estate would be benefited by drainage; that said drainage cannot, however, be accomplished in the best and cheapest manner without affecting the lands of others.

Petitioners would further show that a proper work to accomplish such drainage will affect the following described tracts of land in said county in addition to the above-described real estate, and which said tracts are owned by persons hereinafter named, to-wit:

Petitioners would further show that a certain highway running in an east and west direction through the center of said Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 5 East will be benefited by said proposed drain and that a certain other highway running in a north and south direction through the center of said Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 5 East will also be benefited by said proposed drain.

Petitioners would further represent and show that they believe that the proposed drainage can be accomplished in the cheapest and best manner by a ditch or drain beginning at or near the center of the northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 5 East and running thence in a general northeasterly direction for a distance of about 150 rods and there ending in a natural water course known as White River.

Petitioners further show that they believe that the costs, damages and expenses of such drainage will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the lands likely to be benefited thereby; that the public health will be improved by the proposed drainage and that the said proposed work will be of public utility.

WHEREFORE petitioners pray the court that said ditch and drain be established as provided by law.





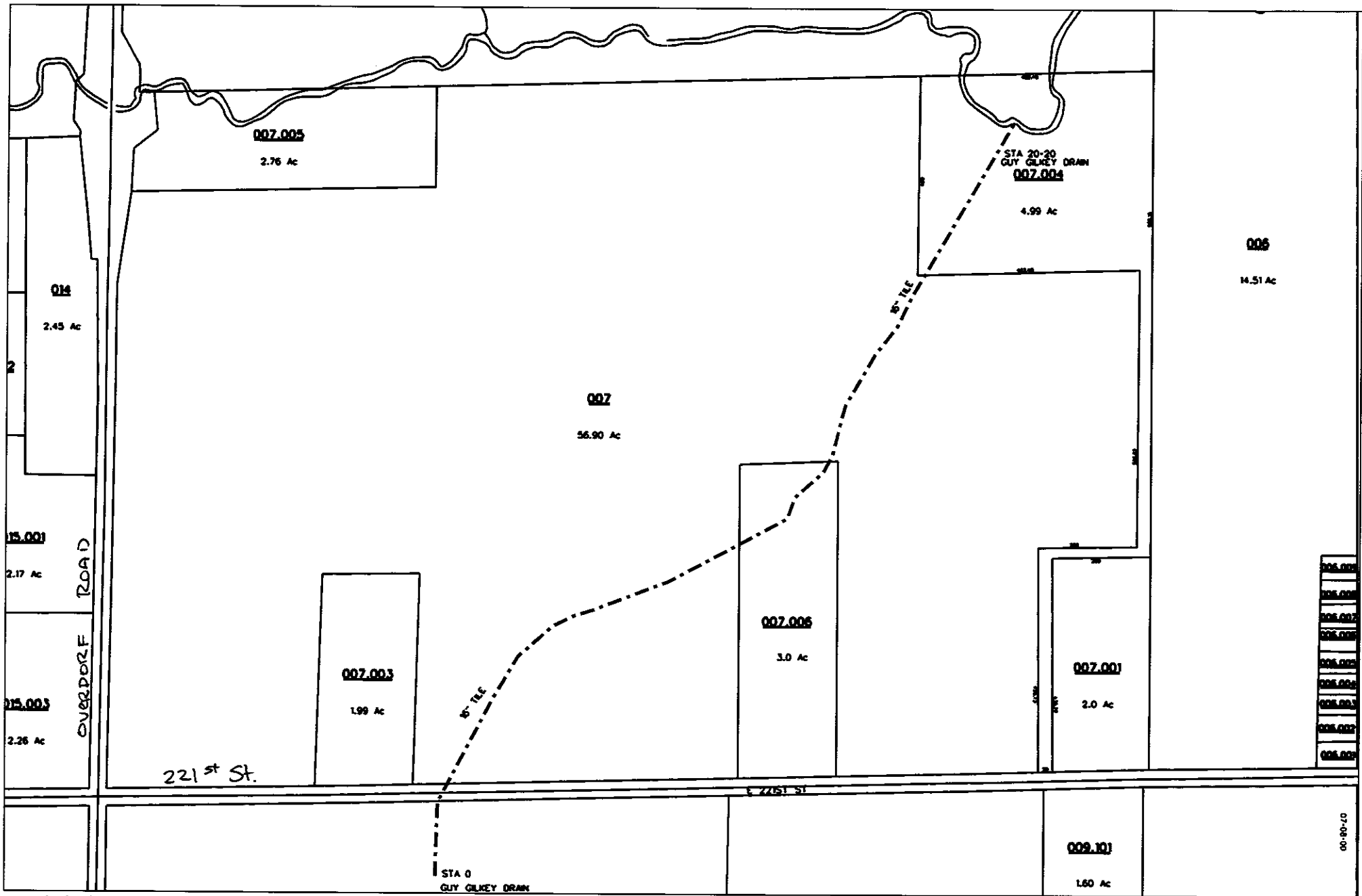
- Tile flowing at time of inspection
