



A regular plastic field pipe without a smooth wall has a resistance factor of 0.011 and a corrugated plastic field tile has a resistance factor of 0.024. This means the smooth wall pipe can carry more water than the regular pipe Mr. Rulon wants to install.
- 2. If maintenance is required on this tile the replacement would be made with smooth double wall tile per contract and specifications for providing periodic maintenance of regulated rural drains in Hamilton County.
