Re: Hilton H. Hobbs Drain.

Attached is a request for waiver of a joint Board in regard to the petition to establish an existing mutual drain as a legal drain. Attached to the request from Tipton County is a copy of the petition, drain map, assessment roll and report on the drain from the Tipton County Surveyor. The establishment of a maintenance assessment of \$2.00 per acre is proposed.

The drain is approximately 5700 feet in length with Hamilton County having approximately 3900 feet. According to Tipton County the drain consists of 16" tile.


Establishing the Hobbs as a legal drain and assessing it for maintenance will reduce the existing maintenance assessment on the Everett Rohrer Drain. Being taken off the Rohrer will be the following:
