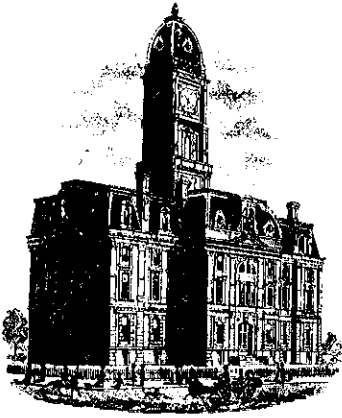

RE: A.J. Huffman Drain

Attached are the plans and assessment roll for a proposed reconstruction of the A.J. Huffman Drain. This drain was placed on maintenance in July 1983 and is a joint drain with Madison County. A waiver of Joint Board is on file from Madison County.

The cost estimate for the reconstruction is as follows:

The limestone removal shall be bid as an alternate and paid per cuyd up to 150 cu yd.

With 502.20 ac in the drainage shed, the total price per acre is \$31.30 with a 1985 \$50.00 minimum.

I recommend a hearing be set for August 12, 1985.

Re: A.J. Huffman Drain

On March 31, 1986 I made the final inspection of the A.J. Huffman Drain reconstruction by Hendricks Excavating. At that time I found the project to be complete and acceptable.

Extra work on the project amounted to 3 six inch tile outlets with animal guards and 95 cubic yards additional on the removal of limestone. The total additional cost is \$3,805.00.

The contract price was \$12,212.50 for the project. With extra work the final cost amounted to \$16,017.50 which is \$298.50 more than the estimate. I recommend that this work be considered maintenance and paid from the maintenance fund for this drain.

The contractor has received at this time \$12,393.00. A claim for the remainder in the amount of \$3,624.50 has been submitted along with the statement for labor and material expenses. I recommend the claim be approved.
