

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations and assessment roll for the Rohrer Woods, Section 2 Arm to the Hunters Creek South Drain.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accuring to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD 1075feet 12" RCP 120feet 18" RCP 70feet 21" RCP 110feet

The total length of the drain will be 1540 feet.

The maintenance of the retention area will be the responsibility of the property owners association. The inlet and outlet of the retention area will be part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$25.00 per lot, \$3.00 per acre for roadways. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$540.78

I recommend a hearing be set for March 1989. I recommend the attached non-enforcement be approved at the time of hearing, if petition is approved.

Petitioner is the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new regulated drain. The drainage will affect various lots in Rohrer Woods Sec. 2, a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will be less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Petetioner believes the proposed improvements will:

- (a) improve public health
- (b) benefit a public street
- (c) be of public utility

Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of construction of the drainage system and requests periodic maintenance assessments by the Board thereafter.

The Petitioner also agrees to the following:

- 1. To provide the Drainage Board a Performance Bond for the portion of the drainage system which will be made a regulated drain. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Engineers estimate. The bond will be in effect until construction of 100% of the system is completed and so certified by the Engineer.
- 2. The Petitioner shall retain an Engineer throughout the construction phase. At completion of the project the Petitioner's Engineer shall certify that the drainage system which is to be maintained as a regulated drain has been constructed as per construction plans.

- 3. The Petitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain File.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The County Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures at Petitioners cost as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an \mbox{Urban} Drain.


SURVE SURVE The storm manhole labeled 104A on the Asbuilt Documents 1. was an addition to the original construction documents, but does not adversely affect the drainage flow.

136' of 12' RCP between structures 104 and 107 was laid 2. at 0.77% slope in lieu of 2.00% this will require an approximately static head of 1.7' above the crown to achieve the design flow. This will still leave 1.6' to the top of casting in Str # 104.

111' of 27" RCP between structures 108 and 109 was laid 3. at 0.05% slope in lieu of 0.15% this will require an approximate static head of 0.2' above the crown to

achieve the design flow.

The swales on lots 28 and 29 need to be reworked to 4. achieve positive drainage, and curb inlets 110, 111, 115 need cleaned of silt from the house 114 & construction.

During construction, changes were made to the drain which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain dated January 9, 1989. The changes are as follows:


110' of 21" RCP was changed to 112' of 21" RCP between Lot 16 & 17
Between STRUCTURES 113 & 114 40' of 18" RCP changed to 41' of 18" RCP


The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 1543 feet.

The non-enforcement of easement was approved by the Board at it's meeting on April 3, 1989.

I recommend the Board approve the drains construction as complete and acceptable.
