Re: Clara Knotts Drain, 103rd Street Homeplace ADA Path Project Reconstruction

Attached are petition, plans, and other information for the proposed reconstruction of the Clara Knotts Drain, for the 103rd Street Homeplace ADA Path Project. The reconstruction was petitioned by the Hamilton County Highway Department. During the path project construction, the Clara Knotts Drain, will be affected and those changes are as follows:

The project will reconstruct a portion of the Clara Knotts Drain, Reconstruction Section 2 Arm. The reconstruction will start at Str. 800 of the 1967 reconstruction, which is at the southeast corner of 103rd Street and Washington Boulevard. It will replace 57 feet of 12" concrete tile and Str. 801, with 55 feet of 12" dual wall plastic pipe and new Str. 206 as shown on sheet 8 of the plans for 103rd Street Homeplace ASA Project, designed by DLZ, dated April 2014, and project number 13831152.

The project will also add new drain from Str. 206 to Str. 205, being 73 feet of dual wall plastic pipe, from Str. 205 to Str. 204, being 73 feet of dual wall plastic pipe, and Str. 204 to Str. 203, being 69 feet of dual wall plastic pipe. Also added is 9 feet of 18" dual wall plastic pipe from existing Str. 712 of the Clara Knotts Drain to Str. 223 of the path project plans.

Project Summary:

The total change to the Clara Knotts Drain length is an increase of 222 feet of new drain installed with this project.

The cost of the reconstruction is to be paid by the Hamilton County Highway Department. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioner's property, the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a noticed hearing is not required for the petition.


Since the petitioner is the Hamilton County Highway Department and is being performed under public bid process, no bond is required for the relocation/reconstruction work.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

The easement for this drain shall be 15' from the centerline of the tile per IC 36-9-27-33. This reconstruction of the regulated drain and addition of new drain will not add any new easement beyond the ROW. Work will be completed in the easement of the following parcels:

PETITION FOR RELOCATION AND RECONSTRUCTION

Hamilton County Highway Department (hereinafter "Petitioner"),
hereby petitions the Hamilton County Drainage Board for authority to relocate and improve a
section of the Clara Knotts Drain, and in support of
said petition advises the Board that:

1. Petitioner owns real estate through which a portion of the Clara Knotts
Drain runs.
2. Petitioner plans to develop its real estate with roads, buildings, utilities, storm drains,
sanitary sewers and other structures.
3. Petitioner's proposed development of its real estate will require relocation and
reconstruction of a portion of the Clara Knotts Drain, as
