

In 1984 the Drainage Board reconstructed the A.F. Ingerman Drain along the east line of the Powers property in order to eliminate a neighborhood problem. The cost of this was to be paid by Mr. Powers.


The total for the work was \$6,493.60 of which Mr. Powers has now paid \$4,100.00 leaving a balance of \$2,393.60. This has been done without charging interest on the unpaid balance although it was taken out of drainage funds per agreement between Powers, Brickey and the Board.

I would recommend the Board place the balance against the Powers property in the Auditor's and Treasurer's books and bill the balance as other reconstructions are billed.



Re: A.F. Ingerman Drain

On October 17, 1984, I made a final inspection on the A.F. Ingerman Drain Reconstruction done by J & W Excavating. At that time I found the project to be complete and acceptable.

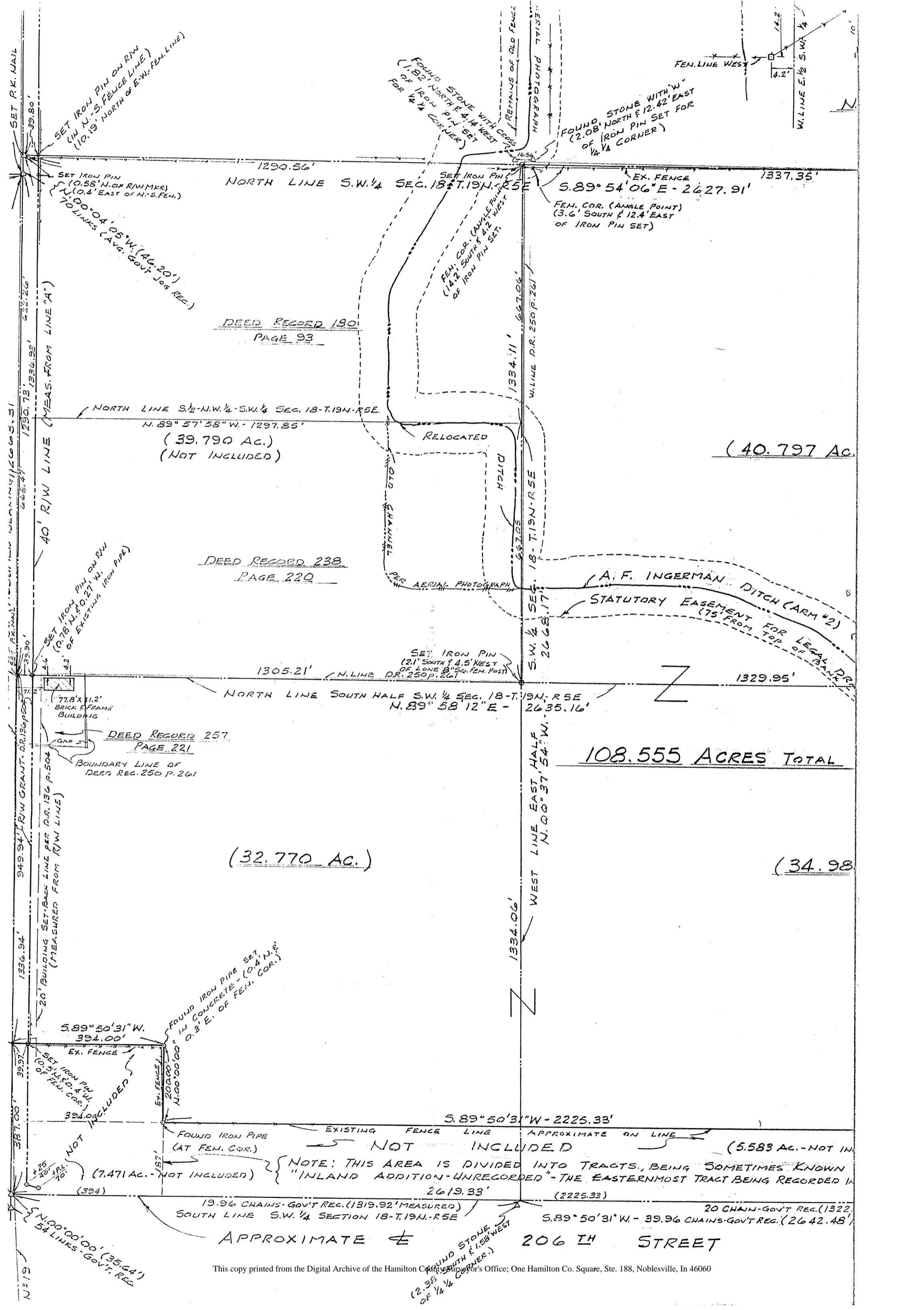
The benches which were proposed were not needed on the East bank. The ditch was moved to the West far enough that the lower 4 feet of the East bank was a fresh cut. The East bank is approximately 9 to 10 feet West of the property line.

Because of the need for additional fill material and erosion control fabric, additional work was needed. This amounted to \$2,017.60. A claim for this amount has been submitted. A claim for 85% of the project cost, \$3,804.60, has been submitted. The remaining \$671.40 will be paid at a later date. A statement that all expenses have been paid has been submitted.
