REPORT OF SURVEYOR AND VIEWERS

The undersigned, surveyor and viewers to whom was referred the above entitled petition for the repair of the George Gardner, R. H. Johnson Ditch and Arms in Hamilton County, in the State of Indiana, respectively report that as directed by the order and mandate of said court we met and made personal inspection of lands described in said petition and all lands likely to be affected by the proposed work, and we would respectfully report as follows;

1. That the drainage proposed is practicable.

2. That the proposal drainage when accomplished will improve the drainage for which it was designed and intended; that it will benefit the public highways hereinafter described; that it will decrease water damage to agricultural crops grown on the land affected by such drain; that it will improve public health.

3. That the costs, damages and expences of affectin the proposed cleanout and repair of said George Gardner, R. H. Johnson and Arms Ditch will be less that the benefits to the owners of lands likely to be benefited by the proposed work of repair.

4. We have definitely determined the best and cheapest method of cleaning and repairing said drain, the terminal and route, location, character of the proposed work and fixed the same by metes and bounds, courses and distances, and description, including grades and bench marks, all necessary Arms, estimated the cost thereof, divided the ditch or drain into section of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section, assessed the benefits or damages, as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the water shed to be affected thereby and to easements held by railroads or other public or private corporations, and to make this report to the court under oath.

LOCATION. Begin approximately one (1) mile north and three-quarters (3/4) mile east of Joliett-at the end of a tile, near the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 19 North, Range 3 East, thence in a southwesterly-southeasterly following the old channel or near and terminating into Eagle Creek near the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 18 North, Range 3 East, all in Washington Township, Hamilton County, Indiana.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

The original H. R. <sup>Johnson</sup> Ditch begins at the end of the tile drain approximately 40 rods west of the Northeast corner of the North east Quarter of Section 31, Township 19 North, Range 3 East, thence in a Southsouthwesterly course crossing into the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 31, Township 19 North, Range 3 East at about the center thereof and running thence southwest to south to south line of said Northwest Quarter, thence south by east and crossing into the Southwest Quarter of said Section 31, Township 19 North, Range 3 East, thence south by west through the westerly part of the Town of Jolietville and crossing into the Northwest

Quarter of Section 6 Township 18 North, Range 3 East, thence south deflecting east at abut the middle to the east line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 3 East and crossing into the Southeast Quarter of said Section, thence continue south along the R/W and parallel with the Highway to a point, thence deflecting to the left or east to an open ditch. (We would recommend the ditch to continue along the side of the Road to the Bridge across Eagle Creek, approximately 400 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 3 East, which is where the Original terminated.)

ARM NO. 2. Begin at the end of a 20 inch tile in the west Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 19 North, Range 3 East, near the East side of said West <sup>Half</sup> running thence south and crossing into the Northwest Quarter, Section 5, Township 18 North, Range 3 East, run thence South by west through the North end of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 3 East, terminating into the Main Ditch at the East end of Bridge at Eagle Creek, Station on H.R. / <sup>Johnson</sup> Ditch 173+ or -, Arm No. 2 Station is 80+ terminated into Station 173 from the East side of Bridge is a Natural Stream, very crooked and obstructed by logs, trees and other debris to Station 215+0, where the George Gardner Ditch begins, which was constructed several years ago.

We would recommend from Station 173+00 to Station 215+00 be made a part of this H. R. Johnson Ditch by clearing, changing channel and clearing out the debris, where channel is changed, block upstream end of old cut by depositing stumps, logs and shrubs and dirt, open or clear the lower end so that the excess water can get out to the main ditch.

All dirt from the New cuts to be deposited in the old channel where the old channel is less than 100 feet away.

From Station 215+00 on the George Gardner Ditch, which was constructed originally only with a 1 to 3 foot bottom. The channel is much wider and several crooks to be straightened out.

There are several large trees on the edge of Bank that are a hazard to Ditch and must be taken out, trees debris and should be put in the old channel where straightened and covered, other trees and brush to be burned unless a written permit from the property owner to leave theirs.

ARM NO. 1. Begin 314.0 feet south of the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 17 North, Range 3 East, on the West side of the Road,

Clean out through the Culvert and an open ditch follow along or near old channel in a Southeasterly direction terminating into Eagle Creek approximately 80 rods South and 50 rods West of the East line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 18 North, Range 3 East.

Station 0+00 to 23+0 Equal Station 188+00 on Main Ditch, 3 foot wide bottom with 1 to 1 slope.

ARM 1 to 1. Begin 1020.0 feet south of the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 18 North, Range 3 East, on the west side of the Highway, clean out the culvert and follow an open ditch in a northeasterly direction terminating into Arm No. 1 at approximately Station 12+0, Arm 1 to 1 at approximately Station 11+00, 3 foot bottom.

REQUIREMENTS: Examine the tile ditch north from the end of Main ditch.

Open ditch clear of all trees, mud, shrubs, brush and debris in and along the channel. All brush and trees to be cut and burned 5.0 feet on each side of ditch. No shrubs or trees to be pulled out of bank of ditch. But shall be cut close to ground on slopes and pulled out of the bottom of ditch.

— All stumps and shrubs to be sprayed with an approved Brush Killer.

At approximately Station 95 to 100 through the deep cut, move the ditch west so the top of the east bank will be 20.0 feet inside of the fence line,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to 1 slope.

— Clear out all pipe, bridges and private culverts. If pipe are not on grade, take up and replace to grade, ~~except Railroad culvert,~~

At station approximately 167+0 continue new ditch straight along road, west bank to be 25 feet east of the Section line to end of bridge.

— On the south east bank of creek drive a row of 7 foot Steel Sheet Piling 4.0 feet below the bed of the Stream, 50 feet east from Bridge. Anchor both end and one in middle with rods and cable to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

All fences, water gaps to be moved and replace by the Contractor. He shall not furnish any new material, using old only.

— All shrubs and clearing to be piled and burned and not covered with dirt unless authorized by the engineer.

The contractor shall move all fences and replace the same, but not furnish any new material.

Clean out from under all highway bridges and other culverts and pipe on ditch, ~~except Railroad culvert or pipe.~~

The assessments will be due and payable when work is started.

The assessments are on an acreage basis.

The contractor is not to receive more than 70% of the value of work completed as work progresses. The Contractor to receive payment only when assessments are paid in. The work to be completed in \_\_\_\_\_ days from time contract is awarded, unless authorized otherwise by the engineer.

All work to be done in a neat and workmanlike manner and expedited as rapidly as practical after the work is started.

Work to be done by mechanical equipment.

The work to be advertised and awarded to lowest and best bidder. The Engineer reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids. The work to be bid in one lump sum for complete job.

The contractor to furnish all labor, equipment, material and bond for completion of work and carry compensation insurance and security bond protecting the engineer and property owners from any and all damages.

All dirt to be leveled.

The contractor to meet all requirements of State pertaining to Questionnaire and Financial Statement.

The contractor to bid, corrugated pipe in place for the following sizes, 10 inch, 12 inch, 15 inch, 18 inch, 21 inch, also tile in place in the same sizes.

At Station No. 113+ on the H. R. Johnson Ditch (Main) where the ditch crosses under the Central Indiana RR R/W there is a 60 inch pipe through the R/W, which is approximately 1.0 foot below grade, the area of this water shed is approximately 823 acres, which would require a minimum of 1-72 inch pipe or 2-48 inch pipe extra approximately 50 foot long each, we would recommend that the RR increase the Water Gage to this additional amount.

TILE DITCH- MAIN DITCH and Arm No. 2, any work on examining or repairing tile north of the end of the open ditch will be extra expence for the ones benefited on the tile portion.

Where the open ditch lies on the east side of the North and South Highway the dirt shall be deposited and leveled far enough to replace fence 5 foot from the break of bank on the natural ground.
