

The report of the viewers was favorable and was filed.

Report of R. D. Horney, County Surveyor who was appointed to supervise the construction of the above drain, would respectfully report that he has made a survey of the above drain and did proceed and definitely determine the best and cheapest method of drainege, the termini and route, location, character of the proposed work, and fix the same by metes and bounds, courses and distance and description, including grades and bench marks, including all necessary erms, estimated the cost thereof, divide the drain or ditch into sections of not more than one hundred feet in length, and computed and set out the number of cubic yards of excavation in each section, assessed the benefits or damages, as the case may be, to each separate tract of land in the water shed to be affected thereby, and bo easements held by railway or other corporations, as well as to cities, towns, or other public or private corporations, including any land rights, easements, or water power, injuriously or beneficially affected, and do make report to court, under oath.

Recomendations

A right of way 161 feet wide on each side of ditch, Clear and clean open portion from Head Wall 400 feet down ditch. Clear 5 feet back from break of bank on each side.

The old tile ditch now in existance has been in for more than 50 years, the tile are too small. Some broken down in many places and never repaired, the tile are filled up and the cost of taking up and replacing would cost more than cutting a new ditch.

Construct a new 6 inch tile ditch:

Begin approximately 160 feet mast and 185 feet North of the S.W. Corner of W.3 of S.W.4 of Section 14 Township 19 North Range 3 East Run Northeasterly 293 feet terminating in Main ditch at Station 5. Station 5 on Main ditch and Station 0 on Arm, This staking begins at Head Wall and Runs up the ditch.

#### Specifications

All tile to be first class meeting Standard A.S.T.M. Specifications Ditch to be cut to grade and straight, Tile to be laid tight joints? Straight, and true. When tile are laid just cover enough to hold until final inspection before balance of back fill.

After the Engineer or his authorized Agent accepts the tile the ditch shall be filled complete. All broken tile shall be sisposed of and all brush shall be furned before the jog will be accepted.
