

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To: Hamilton County Drainage Board

Re: Joel Haworth Drain

The Joel Haworth Drain is a tile drain located in Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 4 East in Jackson Township. The drain was constructed in 1953 through the Circuit Court and is 2340 feet in length. There are claims on file for two drain repairs prior to the 1965 drainage code. An inspection was made on this drain on November 5th. At that time the drain appeared to be in good condition except for work needed on the catch basins on Arms 1 & 2. Because of this I believe that the drain should be placed on a maintenance program with the assessment for the first year being at \$5.00 per acre, \$10.00 minimum. With 84.60 acres in the drainage shed assessed, this would generate \$435.00 which should cover the cost of the needed repair. After the first year the assessment should be reduced to \$2.00 per acre with a \$6.00 minimum and the total yearly assessment will be \$180.00.

I recommend a maintenance hearing be set for 1:40 P.M. on January 4, 1983.
