TO: Hamilton County Drainage Board

RE: W.C. Inman Drain Extension

Attached is a drain map for the extension of the W.C. Inman Drain. This proposed drain is located in Washington Township.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

Open Ditch - 1,181 feet

The extension shall begin at Sta. 40+00 of the W.C. Inman Drain, per the Viewers Report to the Hamilton County Commissioners dated August 9, 1905 (See Hamilton County Commissioners Record Book 16, Pages 110-113). Thence run downstream within the existing open ditch 1,181 feet to its intersection with the Isaac Jones Drain.

The easement for the drain should be set at 75' from the top of bank as set out in IC36-9-27-33. According to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map, Map Number 18057C0110F a majority of this area is covered by the flood plain for the Isaac Jones Drain.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **W. C. Inman Drain Extension** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing **on August 24**, **2009**, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the W. C. Inman Drain Extension be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
