Re: William Lehr Drain, L.N. Joseph & Eli Brooks Arm

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the L.N. Joseph & Eli Brooks Arm of the William Lehr Drain. The relocation is being proposed by Arbor Homes, LLC. The proposal is to relocate the William Lehr Drain tile along the perimeter of Waterman Farms Sections 1 and 2 and parcel 10-11-16-00-00-022.003 owned by Arbor Investments, LLC.

The line will consist of the following:

12" SSD 3,998 ft. Open Ditch 3,990 ft. 12" RCP 8 ft.

The total length of new tile shall be 3,998 feet. The 2,846 feet of the original 1893 drain between Sta. 21+48 and Sta. 49+94 shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 1,152 feet to the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Arbor Homes, LLC. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioners property the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing with 30 day notice is not required for the petition.

Re: Wm. Lehr: Waterman Farms Relocation

Attached are plans, and other information for Waterman Farms. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated December 8, 2005. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held December 22, 2005. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 8, Pages 568-9) The changes are as follows:

Note: the 12" HDPE and the regulated swale/ open ditch are parallel drain.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **3937 feet**. The original Wm. Lehr between Sta. 21+48 and Sta. 49+49 was vacated. Therefore, the project added 1,136 feet to the watersheds length.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on December 22, 2005 and recorded under instrument #200600004913.

The following sureties were guaranteed by Bond Safeguard Company and expired on August 23, 2006.




I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.

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
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
