Come now Joseph Ostwin by his attorney and files his remonstrance to the report of the Commission herein which remonstrance is in these words and figures as follows (See Encl) and the court having heard the evidence and being fully advised reduces the assessment of the Remonstrant on his lands to the sum of seventy five dollars. It is therefore concluded by the court that said report be and the same is hereby modified, so as to assess against the lands of Joseph Ostwin, the sum of seventy five dollars benefits only, and that he recover all his costs and charges in the matter of said remonstrance laid out and expended, to be paid out of the assessments of the assessments of benefits of the lands assessed for the construction of said ditch. And the court now ^{expressly} approves the report of the Commission of drainage heretofore filed, as modified, and does establish said ditch and ordain the same constructed and the same is referred to James Mc Muller for construction which report is in these words and figures as follows

To the Honorable Judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court.
The undersigned commission of drainage to whom was referred the petition of John D Edwards et al. for the drainage of certain lands beginning at, or near the south west corner of the South East quarter of section 35, Township 17 Range 3 east and extending in a South westerly direction to the South west corner of the East half of the South west quarter of section 8 Township 18 Range 3, east in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will improve the public health of the neighborhood through which it runs, the public highways will be kept and will be a public utility and the same can be done

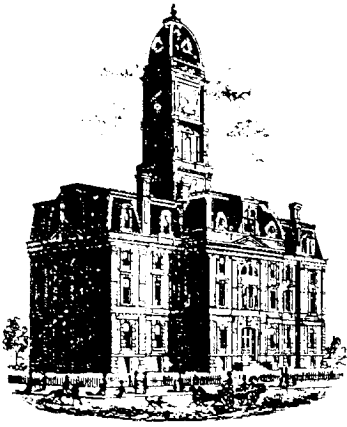

Anna Kendall Drain, Shed Change


