Re: Little Eagle Creek Drain, State Road 32 Extension

Attached is a drain map for the Little Eagle Creek Drain, State Road 32 Extension. This proposed drain is located in Washington Township.

This extension was set out in my classification report to the Board dated April 22, 2010 and approved by the Board on May 10, 2010 at which time the Board referred the list to the surveyor for maintenance and reconstruction of drains as listed. This extension is a reconstruction of the Little Eagle Creek Drain and is necessary so as to properly drain the lands affected as per IC 36-9-27-34(b) (E). This report is being submitted per IC 36-9-27-49. This extension, which creates a new arm of the drain is authorized by subsection (b) (2) of Section 49. The drain is to be accepted in place without reconstruction costs or reconstruction assessment.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

Open Ditch – 2,165 feet

The Little Eagle Creek Drain, State Road 32 Extension shall begin at the west right of way line of Eagletown Road, and run downstream within the existing Little Eagle Creek 2,165 feet to the south right of way of State Road 32. The beginning point is the current terminus of the Little Eagle Creek Drain, Eagletown Road Extension, per my report dated February 22, 2010 and approved by the Board at hearing on April 26, 2010. (See Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 12, Pages 489-490).

The nature of future maintenance work which may be required to adequately drain all affected land is as follows:

1. Bank erosion protection and/or seeding.

- 1. Bank erosion protection and/or seeding.
- 2. Removal of debris and/or blockages from existing open drain;
- 3. Removal of beaver dams;
- 4. Any other repairs necessary to restore proper flow to the open ditch.

The frequency with which future maintenance work should be performed is annually as required by the condition of the drain.

The easement for the drain on the remaining parcels should be set at 75' from the top of bank as set out in IC 36-9-27-33. According to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map, Map Number 18057C0115F, the area for the Little Eagle Creek Open Ditch is covered by the floodplain for Little Eagle Creek. Therefore, I believe that no damages will result to landowners by the regulating of this drain.

### FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Little Eagle Creek Drain, S. R. 32 Extension came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on July 26, 2010, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Little Eagle Creek Drain, S. R. 32 Extension be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
