

Attached are plans for dredging the open portion of the Stuart-Rawlings Drain. This clean out is necessary in order to free the outlets of the tile portion of the drain. Because of the amount needing dredged an additional 600' of drain is needed to be made a legal drain. The cost estimate for this work is \$5495.00. At this time there is \$4326.61 in the maintenance fund. I believe \$2000 should be used out of the maintenance fund with the remainder of the cost paid with a reconstruction assessment. The cost per acre for the reconstruction would be \$4.39. The maintenance cost should remain at the present rate.

Also while working on the Drainage Shed I found revisions which should be made at this time. The following tracts should be reduced.

Attached is a claim for J & W Excavating in the amount of \$459.97. This represents the 15% retainer on the contract price.

Upon paying this claim the total project cost will be \$5,398.03. This includes the contract bid price of \$3,066.51 and the cost of the extra work involved. The extra work consisted of dredging an additional 320 feet of open ditch which will lengthen the drain to the Ford Crossing on the Moore Farm. Also included are tile outlet pipe, additional spreading on the Moore property and a surface water pipe on Dempsey. Although the final cost is above the contract price it is still below the cost estimate of \$5,495.00 given the Board at its April 7, 1980 meeting.
