Re: Long Branch Drain

Per the Board's request at its May 14, 2007 meeting, I have reviewed the future needs of the Long Branch Drain. Upon doing so I believe that the period of collections should be extended from 4 years to 8 years as per IC 36-9-27-43. At this time the total annual collection is \$19,839.80 and the current balance is \$53,599.37. Currently, the maintenance collection of the drain is omitted when the fund reaches \$79,359.20. If the time period for collections is extended the balance in the fund could be \$158,718.40 depending on maintenance work performed on the drain.

This will provide additional funding in the future for clearing, dredging and for possible future reconstruction.

I recommend that this proposal be set for hearing on January 28, 2008.
